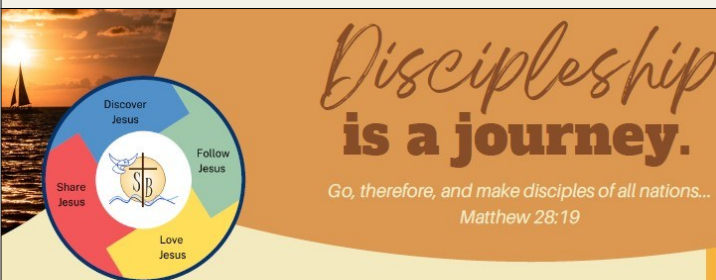

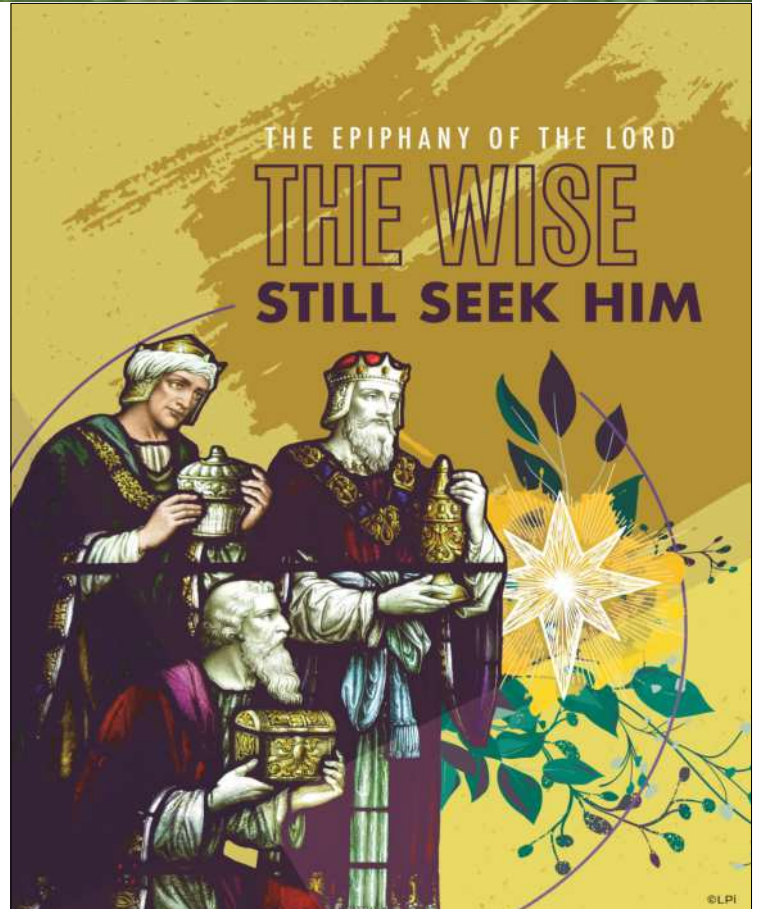

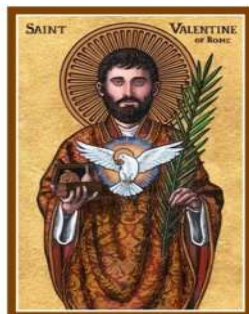

# Young Family & Youth Group Happenings



Our Confirmation prep class (Purpose) meets on Sunday mornings and then attends the 10am Mass together. In the December class the Key Concepts of the teaching were:

- Jesus' mission was to bring about the Kingdom of God. He did so by teaching, working miracles, and, most importantly, forgiving sins.
- Jesus came for the meek: those questioning the existence of God, the sinners, the broken-hearted, the enslaved, the overlooked.
- Jesus asks us, "Who do you say I am?" We must offer a response; our response determines our relationship with Him.

Our High School group (Life Teen) meets on Wednesday nights. On a recent evening in December the key Concepts of the teaching were:

- Human beings are fascinated by the concept of otherworldly powers. Throughout history, people have sought ways to experience and harness this unexplainable power through practices such as witchcraft and magic.
- Though they may appear harmless, witchcraft and magic are violations of the First Commandment and open us to the influence of evil powers that desire to dominate the human race.
- God is the Creator of the universe and has the ability to display his miraculous power as he wills. These miracles strengthen our faith and draw us closer to him.

Our Middle School group (Edge) meets on Wednesday nights. On a recent evening in December the key concepts of the teaching were:

- Anxiety is a feeling of fear, dread, or uneasiness that can be a normal response to stress. It can be a helpful emotion that motivates us to focus and stay alert, but can become a problem if it is persistent, intense, or hard to control.
- God does not want us to live in fear. In the Bible, we see how God comfortingly tells us not to be afraid because he cares for us and has overcome all evil.
- We can turn to prayer as a helpful practice to calm anxiety and invite God to walk with us through our difficulties.

Our K-5 students meet on Wednesday nights, and within their families at home.

- Throughout the Advent and Christmas Seasons the 1<sup>st</sup> Communion students were able to begin a new adventure within the Pathways program.
- They were able to take time to set up a family gathering space, and encouraged to see the great qualities that each family member has. They are called to continually 'call out' those qualities each time they see them!
