#### Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Rosalie and St. John Bosco Churches and Alumni,

Four days into the Lenten Season, we can check in regarding our Lenten practices. Have these four days been business as usual with no thought about doing something special for Lent to deeper our relationship with Jesus?

The cover of today's bulletin provides space to list what you are doing this Lent to deepen your relationship with Jesus. This written list can be kept on your bedside table. Before retiring, you can check how you did in keeping your Lenten resolutions. If you kept them, thank God. If not, resolve to do better tomorrow.

The traditional Lenten practices are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving.

I like to combine the three into two: Works of Self-Denial and Works of Charity.

Works of Self-Denial strengthen us to be better able to resist the temptations of the Devil. Self-Denial builds self-discipline and entails sacrifice. When we sacrifice something for the love of God or neighbor, it becomes holy.

Works of Charity benefit those around us. We give of our time, treasure, and talent to help those in need.

- A) It is interesting to note that the people of both parishes say that the distance between our two churches is far and that the most direct way is via a street that is lonely and dark. # Westbank Mass Schedule Information vis-a-vis our Salesian Parishes

Info gleaned from the Catholic Churches in Avondale, Belle Chase, Gretna, Harvey, Marrero, Terrytown, Waggaman, and Westwego.



#### On Sundays, the earliest Masses at 7:30 a.m.:

St. Rosalie, St. Joseph in Gretna, and St. Joseph the Worker in Marrero.

Our St. John Bosco – St. Rosalie Youth & Young Adult Mass at 8:00 p.m. Sunday evening is the last Sunday Mass on the Westbank.

#### For Sunday Vigil Masses:

Holy Guardian Angels in Bridge City does not have a Vigil Mass; Christ the King in Terrytown has two. All the other parishes have one spanning with starting times from 4:00 p.m. (10); 4:30 p.m. (1); 5:00 p.m. (4); 5:30 p.m. (2); 6:00 p.m. (2); 6:30 p.m. (1)

Fifteen Parishes have no Saturday morning Masses. St. Rosalie, St. John Bosco, and St. Anthony have Saturday morning Masses every Saturday. Two parishes have a Saturday morning Mass on the 1st Saturday of the month.

Only St. Rosalie and St. John Bosco have regular morning Masses, Monday thru Saturday.



St. Rosalie and St. John Bosco are the only parishes on the Westbank that are administered by a Religious Community.

These two parishes share in the Salesian Charism which is found also among the Salesians of Don Bosco, the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians (Salesian Sisters), the Salesian Cooperators, Archbishop Shaw High School, the Academy of Our Lady, Our Lady of Prompt Succor School, and Immaculate Conception School.

It is the pastor's opinion that the Salesian Charism and Spirit is a true gift to all the people of the Westbank.

The Salesian Charism and Spirit is lived by tens of thousands of students, parishioners and alumni from 1933 till this present day.


