How You Can Spiritually Assist Those Who Are Dying

1. Make arrangements for a priest to administer the **Sacrament of the Sick** and give the **Apostolic Pardon**. The Apostolic Pardon remits all temporal punishment due to forgiven sin.

2. **The Divine Mercy Chaplet:** Jesus said: "My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. ... Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful Savior (Diary, 1541). Earlier, Our Lord said to her, "At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for a dying person, the indulgence is the same" (Diary, 811).

3. **Commendation of the Dying:** One or more of the following texts may be prayed with or recited for the dying person. They may be repeated softly two or three times.

Who can separate us from the love of Christ?

Whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.

We have an everlasting home in heaven.

We shall be with the Lord forever.

We shall see God as he really is.

To you, Lord, I lift up my soul.

The Lord is my light and salvation.

My soul thirsts for the living God.

The Lord says, today you will with me in paradise.

Though I walk in the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for you are with me.

In my Father's home there are many dwelling places, says the Lord Jesus.

The Lord Jesus says, I go to prepare a place for you and I will come again to take you to myself.

I desire that where I am, they also may be with me says the Lord Jesus.

Everyone who believes in the Son has eternal life.

Into your hands, Lord, I commend my spirit.

Holy Mary, pray for me.

St. Joseph, pray for me.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, assist me in my last agony.

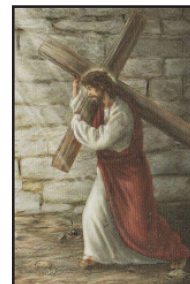

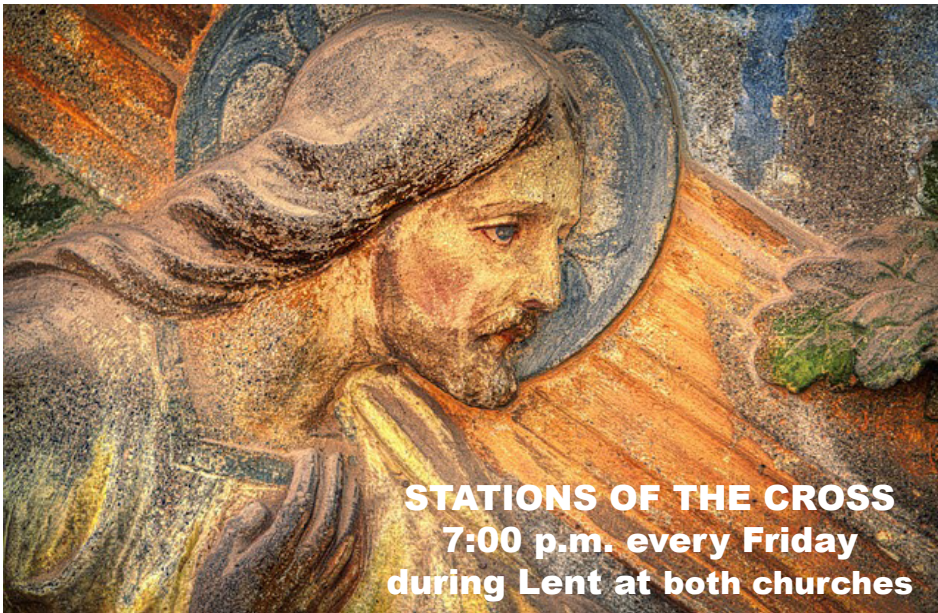
