## **SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION**

### **HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION**

Due to December 8<sup>th</sup> falling on a Sunday of Advent, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception has been moved to Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. Normally, this means that it would no longer be a Day of Obligation, but the Holy See has recently asked the United States to keep it as a Holy Day of Obligation, no matter what day the Solemnity falls. So, that means we will have the typical Holy Day Schedule:

- 8 AM in Yreka
- 12 PM in Hawkinsville – celebrating the Patroness of the Hawkinsville Mission
- 6 PM in Fort Jones

This decision was made by the Holy See because of the importance of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception, who is not only the patroness of the Hawkinsville Mission, but of the entire United States, so we treat this day like a Sunday, trying to limit work if possible, spending time with family, and most importantly, taking the time to worship God in the Holy Mass.
