

He said to the gardener, "For three years now I have come in search of fruit on this fig tree but have found none." - Luke 13:7

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today's Gospel passage (Luke 13:1-9), the Parable of the Fig Tree, speaks directly to us in this holy season of Lent. We are the fig tree, planted in God's vineyard, meant to bear fruit through our faith, love, and good works. Yet, at times, we may find ourselves spiritually stagnant, failing to grow in holiness. As a mom of three, I find comfort in this story as I don't always remain calm and peaceful in the midst of chaos, tantrums, and ears that seem to be incredibly selective to hearing my voice. Oh, how often I can feel like that fig tree - overwhelmed, and not quite measuring up.



Lent is a season of second chances. and renewal. Just as I try to be patient with my children when they make mistakes, God is infinitely patient with me, with us. He sees where we fall short, yet He never gives up on us. He nurtures us, giving us everything we need to grow - if only we open our hearts to Him.

This Parable also carries a sense of urgency "Sir, give it one more chance. Leave it another year...if not you can cut it down". As much as I remind my kids that they don't have to be perfect, I also teach them that growth requires effort. We can't just sit back and expect change. We have to let God's grace work in us, by making space for prayer, repentance, and love in our daily lives.

On this 3rd Sunday of Lent, half-way point if you will, it is a perfect time for self-examination, repentance, and renewal - a time to allow the Divine Gardener to nourish us with His grace so that we may flourish. So this week, I am asking myself: Am I bearing the fruit God calls me to? Am I leading my children by example, showing them faith in action? Am I allowing God to shape me into the mom, the wife, the disciple He wants me to be?

If you've been feeling weary or unfruitful, take heart - God isn't done with you yet. He's the loving gardener, tending to our souls, giving us the grace we need to bloom. Let's trust in His patience and make the most of this season of renewal. With love and prayers, Maggie Sartori


