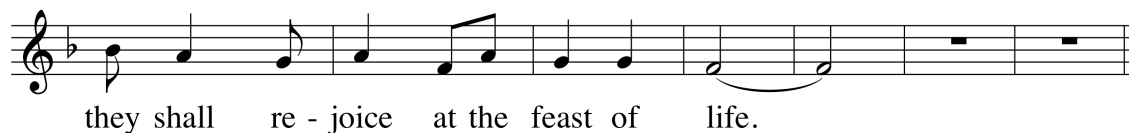
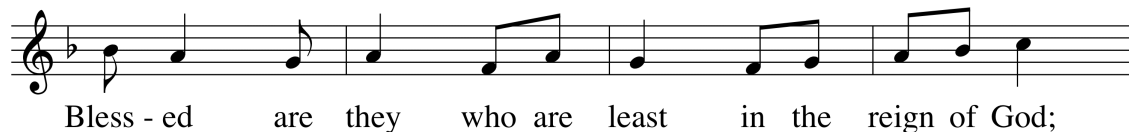
### The Lord's Prayer Sign of Peace Lamb of God

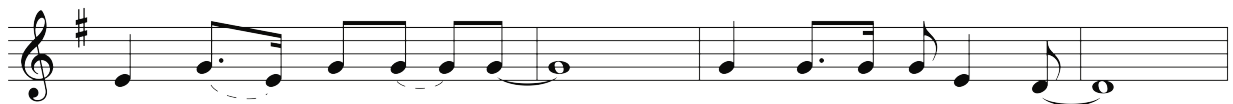
