

Regional (OGG) Planning for Mission: Meeting Agenda (1.5 Hours)

Total Time: 90 minutes

Purpose: To gather in prayer and reflection as we begin the “Planning for Mission” process in our parishes.

St. Ann, Goodridge Monday, November 3, 2025

16 parishioners in attendance.

1. Welcome and Introduction – Jim (5 minutes)

- “Who am I, and why are we here?”
 - Announcement made at parishes.
 - Time to hear from Bishop, adoration, feedback, questions.
- Brief overview of the purpose and spirit of the session.
 - Explain what we will do this evening.
 - Briefly review principles 5-8 from Regional Planning Process document.

2. Why We Are Here – Bishop (15 minutes) – handout offered of Bishop’s talk

- Bishop Cozzens spoke about limits that have been placed upon us with priest assignments, which has led to tonight's gathering.
- Church is ours; we all have a role; we all must go on mission; we must go make disciples. The question is how do we do the mission with the resources that we have.
- Glad to have you here to learn about the process we will need to undertake over the next nine months as we prepare for Father Bryan's departure to a new assignment.
- Pastoral Vision of the Diocese of Crookston; missionary moment of which we live.
- Maintenance mode of living vs. growth and mission.
- Priorities of pastoral vision: Revive, Plan, Evangelize.
- How can we collaborate with area churches to do ministry?
- Missionary impulse question from Pope Francis.

3. Eucharistic Adoration with Benediction (20 minutes)

Guided Reflection Prompts:

Bishop led a guided reflection before the Blessed Sacrament (John 15:1-11). Three questions were provided on a half-page handout which are collected.

1. How have you encountered Jesus at your parish?
2. What is the greatest challenge you face as a parish?
3. What would need to change for your parish to grow?

(Conclusion with Benediction.)

4. Small Group Sharing (15 minutes)

Insights shared in small groups using the half-sheet of reflection questions:

- How have you encountered Jesus at your parish?
- What is the greatest challenge you face as a parish?
- What would need to change for your parish to grow?

5. Large Group Sharing (10 minutes)

- Insights from prayer (names drawn from basket)
 - Encountered Jesus here after confession, Mass, etc after being away for 20 years.
 - Encountered Jesus through leadership from Fr. Bryan and my parents.
 - Encountered Jesus through certain songs or Gospel readings.

6. The Planning for Mission Process – Bishop (15 minutes)

- Distribution of the *Planning for Mission* handout.
 - Goal of the process.
 - Parameters and clusters shared.
 - The need for the process: changed demographics, fewer resources, etc.
 - Parish representatives from St. Ann's and St. Bernard's will work together to come up with recommendations that will go to the Diocesan Planning Commission.
 - Scenarios presented: Clustering, Merger, Oratory, etc.
 - Once the Planning Commission receives the recommendation from the parish committee, they will work out a great recommendation to the Bishop. Then decisions will happen and implementation would occur.
 - Discernment and decisions; implementation; building the new reality together.
- Walk through the steps of the process.
- Address any clarifying questions.

7. Closing and Questions (10 minutes)

- Floor open for questions.
 - What happens to parish financials? (Examples offered about various accounts during mergers.)
 - The need for perpetual care of cemeteries highlighted.
 - Could Mass happen here in Goodridge after a merger? (Answer: That would need to be discerned.)
 - Commentary about parish family and sense of community.
- Closing remarks and blessing.
 - The Our Lady of Guadalupe prayer.
