

MATTERS PERTAINING TO PRIESTS/SEMINARIANS

V. Priests' Retirement Age

- A. It is the policy of this Diocese that priests may retire after they have completed seventy years of age.
- B. If a priest chooses to retire at seventy years of age, he may do so at the beginning of the month following his birthday, or he may wait until July 1 following his birthday.
- C. A priest intending to retire after his seventieth birthday is to inform the Bishop of his intention before the end of the previous calendar year (since this information will be important to personnel planning.)
