HAS IT BEEN THREE YEARS? Every three years, a parish is expected to gather its liturgical ministers, **primarily** its Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lay Leaders of Weekday Celebrations of Holy Communion to provide them with spiritual and practical formation in support their ministries. Names of your EMoHC's need to be submitted by your pastor or administrator by letter to the Bishop, and then publicly commissioned during Mass in your parish. Those who have been trained to be Lay Leaders of Weekday Celebrations of Holy Communion also need to be submitted by letter to the Bishop and be publicly commissioned; in addition, these leaders are required to go through our diocesan Safe Environment process since they have potential contact with vulnerable populations.
