Jesus is calling all to be His missionary disciples. Pope Francis shares: "In virtue of our baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples"

Everyone is called to share the Good News of Jesus with the world. It might be through your daily actions, performing corporal or spiritual works of mercy, sharing your "faith story" with someone else, accompanying people in their lives, or inviting someone to come with you to Mass. There are so many ways that one can be a missionary disciple of Jesus Christ.

The foundation to our ministry as His disciples is prayer. Central to this is the Mass and daily prayer is also important. This booklet contains 31 prayers on missionary discipleship, one prayer for each day of the month. If you already pray daily, consider including this prayer in your practice. If you do not regularly pray, try to pray one of these short prayers every day. When you reach the end of the month, start the next month with the first prayer and continue to work your way through these prayers every month.

God Bless you as you seek to understand how God is calling you to be His missionary disciple in the world.
