VII. Celebrating the Eucharist in a Protestant Church

- A. For a just cause and with the express permission of the local Ordinary, it is licit for a priest to celebrate the Eucharist in a sacred edifice of another church or ecclesial community that does not have full communion with the Catholic Church (c. 933).
- B. The priest must be able to assure the Ordinary that no scandal will be given if this permission is given.
