II. Times for Liturgies during the Triduum

- A. The Mass of the Lord's Supper is celebrated in the evening, at a convenient hour, with the full participation of the whole local community and with all the priests and clergy exercising their ministry.
 - In the Diocese of Crookston, another Mass of the Lord's Supper may be celebrated for a congregation in the evening prior to the principal Mass.
 - 2. In the Diocese of Crookston, no morning Mass is permitted on Holy Thursday.
- B. The celebration of the Lord's passion takes place in the afternoon, about three o'clock, unless pastoral reasons suggest a later hour.
- C. The entire celebration of the Easter Vigil takes place at night. It should not begin before nightfall; it should end before daybreak on Sunday.
