VI. On the "Cautio" Attached to an Annulment

- A. The priest involved with the case, who receives notification of the annulment, should contact the Tribunal to ascertain if a "cautio" has been attached to the annulment, i.e., a caution that must be attended to prior to marriage following an annulment.
- B. Any priest dealing with the preparation for marriage of a couple, one of whom has received an annulment (and maybe both), should ALWAYS contact the Tribunal to ascertain the presence or absence of a "cautio."
- C. There are two levels of "cautiones":
 - The first level requires PREPARE/ENRICH and pastoral counseling. This level pertains to everyone considering marriage after an annulment.
 - The second level requires, in addition to the above, professional counseling with Catholic Charities or another approved agency. In this case, no arrangements for a future marriage should be made until this requirement has been met.
