

How to Request a Papal Blessing

The Diocese of Crookston (or any other diocese) does not issue Papal blessings. Instead, requests for Papal blessings are handled by the Apostolic Nunciature (the embassy of the Holy See to the United States).

There are two (2) types of certificates of Papal Blessing: 1) a printed certificate and 2) a handwritten blessing on parchment.

#1 The request for a Papal Blessing, in the form of a printed certificate, should be made in a letter addressed to:

Enclose the following with your request (a sample of which can be found below):

1. A written recommendation from a parish priest of the persons to receive the blessing, or from a priest familiar with the persons, attesting to their good standing in the Catholic Church.

In the case of a wedding, both parties should be Catholics. (For anniversaries, it is sufficient that one of the members is Catholic.) For priests, parishes, pious associations or organizations, the request should be presented by the Diocesan Bishop. For religious, the request should come from their Superior.

2. A sample letter from your parish priest can be found below.

3. The contents of the blessing, clearly including:

3.1. The name(s) (typed or written in capital letters) of the people to receive the blessing.

3.2. The occasion to be celebrated (birthday, religious profession, first communion, confirmation, wedding, ordination, wedding anniversary, etc.). Anniversaries should be of a special nature, such as the 25th, 50th, or 60th. Birthdays should also be special, such as 80th or 90th, and so on.). A general blessing for no specific occasion may also be requested.

3.3. The date of the occasion/birthday/anniversary.

3.4. If the blessing is for a wedding, include the name of the church, its city and state.

4. An offering of \$20.00, by check or money order, made payable to the "*Apostolic Nunciature*."

Please indicate the address to which the certificate should be sent, as well as the diocese to which the persons to receive the blessing belong. All requests should be presented in writing. Please allow a minimum of two to three weeks. Requests by e-mail are not acceptable.

#2 To request a handwritten Papal blessing on parchment, you should request it directly from the Servizio Assistenziale del Santo Padre at the Vatican.

Enclose the following with your request (a sample of which can be found below):

1. A written recommendation from a parish priest of the persons to receive the blessing, or from a priest familiar with the persons, attesting to their good standing in the Catholic Church. In the case of a wedding, both parties should be Catholics. A sample letter from your parish priest can be found below.
2. The contents of the blessing, clearly printed, including:
 - 2.1. The name(s) (typed or written in capital letters) of the people to receive the blessing.
 - 2.2. The occasion to be celebrated (birthday, wedding, ordination, wedding anniversary, etc.). Anniversaries should be of a special nature, such as the 25th, 50th, or 60th. Birthdays should also be special, such as 80th or 90th, and so on.
 - 2.3. The date of the occasion/birthday/anniversary.
 - 2.4. If the blessing is for a wedding, include the name of the church, its city and state.

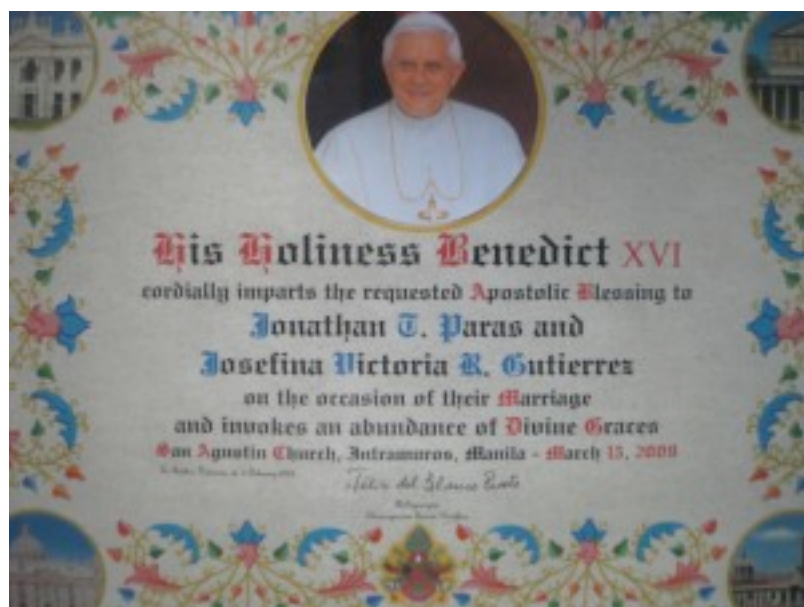
Mail all the above information to:

The customary offering is \$45.00, payable to the Servizio Assistenziale del Santo Padre. Please indicate the address to which the certificate should be sent, as well as the diocese to which the persons to receive the blessing belong. All requests should be presented in writing.

Please be informed that it takes at least two or three months.

Sample Letter Requesting Papal Blessing
