Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

This past July, the Pope sent a message to a gathering of catechists in South America. His words to them contain a message for us all, especially as we begin a new school year and look towards educating in the way of the Lord those entrusted to our care. The Pope taught: "Catechesis is not a 'job'...being a catechist is a vocation of service to the Church; what was received as a gift from the Lord should be transmitted in one's turn. Thus, catechists must constantly return to that first announcement of 'kerygma' (the Word) which is the gift that changed their life.

...Nothing is more solid, profound, secure, meaningful and wisdom-filled than that initial proclamation. This proclamation should accompany faith which is already present in the piety of our people. It is necessary to assume all the potential of piety and love that popular religiosity contains, so that not only are the contents of faith transmitted, but a true school of formation is also established, in which the gift of faith received is nurtured so that actions and words reflect the grace of being the disciples of Jesus.

The Catechist walks from and with Christ...who let themselves be looked at by Him, by that gaze that makes the heart burn. The more Jesus occupies the center of our lives, the more He allows us to come out of our-

selves...and brings us closer to others...coming out of ourselves for love, to bear witness to Jesus and speak of Jesus, to preach Jesus.

...Catechists are creative, they seek to use different means and forms to proclaim Christ...to encounter new signs and ways to transmit the faith. The means may be different but what is important is to keep in mind the style of Jesus Who adapted to the people He had before Him in order to bring them closer to the love of God."

For each one of us, the gift of the Word of God should transform our inner life so that our external, lived expressions of service and companionship towards others enables them to understand how they, too, are called by Christ to bring His love to the world. Heart by heart, hand in hand, we are challenged by the Son of God to join Him in making His Kingdom a reality among us. As we each listen to His Word, let us resolve to be transformed by Its message so that we may become the living signs of the Love of God present in our midst.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

El pasado mes de julio, el Papa envió un mensaje a una reunión de catequistas en América del Sur. Sus palabras para ellos contienen un mensaje para todos nosotros, especialmente cuando comenzamos un nuevo año escolar y miramos hacia la educación en el camino del Señor a los que se confían a nuestro cuidado. El Papa enseñó: "La catequesis no es un" trabajo "... ser catequista es una vocación de servicio a la Iglesia; Lo que fue recibido como un regalo del Señor debe ser transmitido en su turno. Así, los catequistas deben volver constantemente a ese primer anuncio del 'kerygma' (la Palabra), que es el don que cambió su vida.

... Nada es más sólido, profundo, seguro, significativo y lleno de sabiduría que esa proclamación inicial. Esta proclamación debe acompañar a la fe que ya está presente en la piedad de nuestro pueblo. Es necesario asumir todo el potencial de piedad y amor que contiene la religiosidad popular, de modo que no sólo se transmiten los contenidos de la fe, sino que se establezca también una verdadera escuela de formación en la que el don de la fe recibido se nutra para que las acciones Y las palabras reflejan la gracia de ser los discípulos de Jesús.

El Catequista camina desde y con Cristo ... que se deja ver por Él, por esa mirada que hace arder el corazón. Cuanto más Jesús ocupa el centro de nuestras vidas, más Él nos permite salir de nosotros mismos ... y nos acerca a los demás ... saliendo de nosotros mismos por amor, para dar testimonio de Jesús y hablar de Jesús, para predicar a Jesús.

... Los catequistas son creativos, buscan usar diferentes medios y formas para proclamar a Cristo ... para encontrar nuevos signos y formas de transmitir la fe. Los medios pueden ser diferentes, pero lo importante es tener en cuenta el estilo de Jesús que Se adaptó al pueblo que tenía delante para acercarlos al amor de Dios ".

Para cada uno de nosotros, el don de la Palabra de Dios debe transformar nuestra vida interior para que nuestras expresiones externas de servicio y de compañerismo hacia los demás les permitan entender cómo ellos también son llamados por Cristo para traer Su amor a la mundo.
