Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Last Friday, September 22, the autumnal equinox occurred at 4:02 PM. Just like the change of seasons, there are some major changes taking place for both physical plants of Saints Mary and Ambrose churches.

Those of us who regularly attend Saint Mary church will note that (once again!) the statue of Saint Joseph has been taken down from its pedestal in the sanctuary. It has been moved, for safe-keeping, to the annex, while the restoration of the church chimney takes place. Starting this coming week, the scaffolding for the tear-down and rebuilding of the chimney will commence. We will lose the parking spaces along the sidewalk for the next six weeks. Hopefully by Thanksgiving, the chimney will be rebuilt and Saint Joseph's statue will return from its place of protection.

Speaking of lost parking spaces, that will also occur in the north parking lot at Saint Ambrose. As parishioners there know, the city of Anderson has made it official that they have abandoned the alleyways adjacent to our property. That action by the city should have happened back in the 1960's when the church was

built; but, for whatever reason it had never been officially accomplished. Now that that it is a fact, there will be a guard-rail erected along the edge of the parking lot to provide safety for our children as they cross through the property to get to the new playground at the northwest end of the campus. In addition, gates will be strategically placed at the entryways to regulate the flow of traffic during school hours. Three of the parking spaces that were located by the alleyway will no longer be used in order to provide for a traffic-flow throughout the week.

All of this will take place because of your generous cooperation in the stewardship of what has been entrusted to us. By maintaining and improving the physical plants of both campuses, we will hopefully ensure that they remain intact for future generations to share in the faith community established by those who went before us and protected by us for those who will follow. Thanks to each and everyone who has made this a reality in the life of us all.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

El viernes pasado, 22 de septiembre, el equinoccio de otoño ocurrió a las 4:02 PM. Al igual que el cambio de estaciones, hay algunos cambios importantes que tienen lugar tanto para las plantas físicas de las iglesias de San María y Ambrosio.

Aquellos de nosotros que asisten regularmente a la iglesia de Santa María notaremos que (una vez más!) La estatua de San José ha sido sacada de su pedestal en el santuario. Se ha trasladado, para la custodia, al anexo, mientras que la restauración de la chimenea de la iglesia ocurre. A partir de la próxima semana, comenzará el andamiaje para la destrucción y reconstrucción de la chimenea. Perderemos las plazas de aparcamiento a lo largo de la acera durante las próximas seis semanas. Esperemos que por el Día de Acción de Gracias, la chimenea será reconstruida y la estatua de San José volverá de su lugar de protección.

Hablando de estacionamientos perdidos, eso también ocurrirá en el estacionamiento norte de Saint Ambrose. Como saben los parroquianos, la ciudad de Anderson ha hecho oficial que han abandonado las callejuelas adyacentes a nuestra propiedad. Esa acción de la ciudad debería haber ocurrido en la década de 1960 cuando la iglesia fue construida; pero, por alguna razón, nunca se había cumplido oficialmente. Ahora que eso es un hecho, habrá un carril de guardia erigido a lo largo del borde del estacionamiento para proporcionar seguridad a nuestros niños mientras atraviesan la propiedad para llegar al nuevo patio de recreo en el extremo noroeste del campus. Además, las puertas estarán estratégicamente ubicadas en las entradas para regular el flujo de tráfico durante las horas escolares. Tres de los espacios de estacionamiento que se encontraban por el callejón ya no se utilizará con el fin de proporcionar un flujo de tráfico a lo largo de la semana.

Todo esto ocurrirá por su generosa cooperación en la administración de lo que nos ha sido confiado. Manteniendo y mejorando las plantas físicas de ambos campus, esperamos que se mantengan intactos para que las generaciones futuras compartan la comunidad de fe establecida por aquellos que fueron antes de nosotros y protegidos por nosotros para aquellos que lo sigan. Gracias a cada uno y todos los que han hecho esto una realidad en la vida de todos nosotros.
