Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

As we all know, Pope Francis recently visited Myanmar. During his time there he spoke with a group of bishops, sharing his view of what an ordained Christian is called to accomplish in life. He used three key words: healing, accompaniment and prophecy. He stated that since the Gospel of Christ is one of healing, reconciliation and peace, we must be messengers of that grace. "The preaching of the Gospel must not only be a source of consolation and strength, but also a summons to foster unity, charity and healing....For the unity we share and celebrate is born of diversity. Never forget this—it is born of diversity! It values people's differences as a source of mutual enrichment and growth. It invites people to come together in a culture of encounter and solidarity."

The second point of the Pope's reflection was the word accompaniment. "A good shepherd is constantly present to his flock, guiding them as he walks at their side. As I like to say, the shepherd should bear the smell of the sheep. But also, do not forget, the smell of God! In our time, we are called to be a Church which goes forth to bring the light of Christ to every periphery...to build up the flock in holiness, fidelity and a spirit of service...to imbue the laity with a spirit of true missionary discipleship and seek a wise inculturation of the Gospel message in the daily life and traditions of your local communities."

"My third word is prophecy....Here I think in a special way of the need to protect the environment and to ensure a just use of the nation's rich natural resources for the benefit of

future generations. The protection of God's gift of creation cannot be separated from a sound human and social ecology. Indeed, genuine care for our relationship with nature is inseparable from fraternity, justice, and keeping faith with others." In his final comments the Pope acclaimed St. Peter who told the leaders of the early church, "We, for our part, will devote ourselves to prayer and the serving of the word." (Acts 6:1-6)

Our day and its routines need to begin with prayer. They must be nourished as we go through them with an interior spirit of prayer. They need to be brought to completion with a reflective thanksgiving of prayer. In these ways we allow the Spirit of God to inspire, direct and bring to fulfillment the daily tasks and events that we encounter as we make our pilgrimage through this world. Without the assurance of prayer, we falter and can easily fall into sin and discouragement. With prayer we can overcome any obstacle and seek to find the Glory of God among us. May the Lord bless your efforts to accomplish that task each and every day of your life. Peace be with you, Monsignor

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Como todos sabemos, el Papa Francisco visitó recientemente Myanmar. Durante su tiempo allí, habló con un grupo de obispos, compartiendo su visión de lo que un cristiano ordenado está llamado a lograr en la vida. Utilizó tres palabras clave: curación, acompañamiento y profecía. Él afirmó que dado que el Evangelio de Cristo es uno de curación, reconciliación y paz, debemos ser mensajeros de esa gracia. "La predicación del Evangelio no solo debe ser una fuente de consuelo y fortaleza, sino también un llamado para fomentar la unidad, la caridad y la curación ... Porque la unidad que compartimos y celebramos nace de la diversidad. ¡Nunca olvide esto, nace de la diversidad! Valora las diferencias de las personas como una fuente de enriquecimiento mutuo y crecimiento. Invita a las personas a unirse en una cultura de encuentro y solidaridad ".

El segundo punto de la reflexión del Papa fue la palabra acompañamiento. "Un buen pastor está constantemente presente a su rebaño, guiándolos mientras camina a su lado. Como me gusta decir, el pastor debe llevar el olor de las ovejas. Pero también, no lo olvides, ¡el olor de Dios! En nuestro tiempo, estamos llamados a ser una Iglesia que sale a traer la luz de Cristo a todas las periferias ... para construir el rebaño en santidad, fidelidad y espíritu de servicio ... para imbuir a los laicos con un espíritu de verdadero discipulado misionero y busque una inculturación sabia del mensaje del Evangelio en la vida cotidiana y las tradiciones de sus comunidades locales ".

"Mi tercera palabra es profecíaEstoy pensando de una manera especial sobre la necesidad de proteger el medio ambiente y garantizar un uso justo de los abundantes recursos naturales de la nación en beneficio de las generaciones futuras. La protección del regalo de la creación de Dios no puede separarse de una ecología humana y social sana. De hecho, el cuidado genuino de nuestra relación con la naturaleza es inseparable de la fraternidad, la justicia y la fe en los demás ". En sus comentarios finales, el Papa aclamó a San Pedro, quien dijo a los líderes de la iglesia primitiva:" Nosotros, por nuestra parte, dedicarnos a la oración y al servicio de la palabra "(Hechos 6: 1-6)

Nuestro día y sus rutinas deben comenzar con la oración. Deben nutrirse a medida que los atravesamos con un espíritu interior de oración. Deben completarse con una acción de gracias reflexiva de oración. De esta forma, permitimos que el Espíritu de Dios inspire, dirija y lleve a cabo las tareas y eventos diarios que encontramos al hacer nuestra peregrinación por este mundo. Sin la seguridad de la oración, flaqueamos y podemos caer fácilmente en el pecado y el desaliento. Con la oración podemos superar cualquier obstáculo y buscar la Gloria de Dios entre nosotros. Que el Señor bendiga sus esfuerzos para lograr esa tarea todos los días de su vida.
