Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Recently Pope Francis resumed his catechesis on why we ought to go to Mass on Sunday. I would like to share with you some of his thoughts. The Pope stated: "The Sunday celebration of the Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life (see the Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2177). We Christians go to Sunday Mass to encounter the Risen Lord, or better still to allow ourselves to be encountered by Him, to hear His Word, to nourish ourselves at His Table, and thus to become the Church, that is, His Mystical Living Body in the world....Jesus' disciples understood this. They celebrated the Eucharistic encounter with the Lord on the day of the week that the Hebrews called 'the first of the week' and the Romans called 'the day of the sun,' because on that day Jesus rose from the dead and appeared to the disciples, speaking with them, eating with them, giving them the Holy Spirit (see Mt. 28:1; Mk 16:9; Lk. 24:1 and Jn. 20:1)....It is the Mass that makes Sunday Christian."

"...The Eucharist is our guide, Sunday after Sunday. For this reason the Second Vatican Council wished to emphasize that Sunday 'is the original feast day, and it should be proposed to the piety of the faithful and taught to them so that it may become in fact a day of joy and of freedom from work.' (Constitution of the Church, c.106)

....It was the Christian awareness of living as children and not as slaves, inspired by the Eucharist, which made Sunday—almost universally—the day of rest."

"Without Christ we are condemned to be dominated by everyday weariness, with its worries, and by fear of the future. The Sunday encounter with the Lord gives us the strength to experience the present with confidence and courage, and to go forth with hope....Eucharistic communion with Jesus, Risen and ever-Living, anticipates the Sunday without sunset, when there will be no more weariness nor pain, nor sorrow nor tears, but only the joy of living fully and forever with the Lord....We do not go to Mass in order to give something to God, but to receive what we truly need from Him....We Christians need to participate in Sunday Mass because only with Jesus' grace, with His living Presence within us and among us, can we put His commandments into practice, and thus be His credible witnesses."

I cannot improve upon that teaching one bit. Peace be with you, Monsignor

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor: Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma:

- 1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556. 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana.
- 3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.

#### **DESDE EL PASTOR**

#### Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Recientemente, el Papa Francisco reanudó su catequesis sobre por qué deberíamos ir a misa el domingo. Me gustaría compartir con ustedes algunos de sus pensamientos. El Papa afirmó: "La celebración dominical de la Eucaristía está en el corazón de la vida de la Iglesia (véase el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n. 2177). Nosotros los cristianos vamos a la misa dominical para encontrarnos con el Señor resucitado, o mejor aún, para permitirnos ser encontrados por él, escuchar su palabra, alimentarnos en su mesa y así convertirnos en la iglesia, es decir, su cuerpo viviente místico. en el mundo ... Los discípulos de Jesús entendieron esto. Celebraron el encuentro eucarístico con el Señor el día de la semana que los hebreos llamaron "el primero de la semana" y los romanos lo llamaron "el día del sol", porque ese día Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos y se apareció al discípulos, hablando con ellos, comiendo con ellos, dándoles el Espíritu Santo (ver Mt. 28: 1; Marcos 16: 9; Lucas 24: 1 y Juan 20: 1) ... Es la misa que hace que el Domingo Cristiano "

"... La Eucaristía es nuestra guía, domingo tras domingo. Por esta razón, el Concilio Vaticano II quiso enfatizar que el domingo "es la fiesta original, y debe ser propuesta a la piedad de los fieles y enseñada a ellos para que se convierta de hecho en un día de alegría y de liberación del trabajo". . '(Constitución de la Iglesia, c.106) .... Fue la conciencia cristiana de vivir como niños y no como esclavos, inspirados por la Eucaristía, lo que hizo que el domingo -casi universalmente- fuera el día del descanso ".

"Sin Cristo estamos condenados a ser dominados por el cansancio cotidiano, sus preocupaciones y el miedo al futuro. El encuentro dominical con el Señor nos da la fuerza para experimentar el presente con confianza y coraje, y avanzar con esperanza ... La comunión eucarística con Jesús, Resucitado y siempre vivo, anticipa el domingo sin puesta de sol, cuando ya no habrá más cansancio ni dolor, ni tristeza ni lágrimas, sino solo la alegría de vivir plenamente y para siempre con el Señor ... No vamos a Misa para darle algo a Dios, sino para recibir lo que realmente necesitamos de Él ... Nosotros, los cristianos Necesitamos participar en la Misa dominical porque solo con la gracia de Jesús, con su presencia viviente dentro de nosotros y entre nosotros, podemos poner sus mandamientos en práctica y así ser sus testigos creíbles ".
