Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

In a recent audience address, Pope Francis spoke of the pilgrimage of faith. His words merit sharing. He said: "The Gospel narrative indicates the essential characteristics of the journey of faith. There is a journey of faith, and this journey of the disciples of all times, ours too, beginning with the question that Jesus asks the two who, urged by the Baptist, set out to follow Him: "What do you seek?" (Jn.1:38). It is the same question that the Risen One asks Mary Magdalene on Easter morning: 'Woman, whom so you seek?' (Jn. 20:15). Each of us, as a human being, is seeking: seeking happiness, seeking love, a good and full life. God the Father has given us all this in His Son Jesus.

"In this search, the role of a true witness—of a person who first made the journey and encountered the Lord—is fundamental. In the Gospel, John the Baptist is this witness. For this reason he is able to direct the disciples toward Jesus, Who engages them in a new experience, saying: 'Come and see (Jn.1:39)"....Only a personal encounter with Jesus engenders a journey of faith and of discipleship. We will be able to experience many things, to accomplish many things, to establish

relationships with many people, but only the appointment with Jesus, at that hour that God knows, can give full meaning to our life and render our plans and our initiatives fruitful.

"...The life of faith consists in the wish to able in the Lord, and thus is a continuing search for the place where He lives. This means that we are called to...rekindling the encounter with Jesus in prayer, in meditating on the Word of God and in practicing the Sacraments, in order to abide with Him, and bear fruit thanks to Him, to His help, to His grace. Seeking Jesus, encountering Jesus, following Jesus: this is the journey...May the Virgin Mary support us in this prospect of following Jesus, of going to abide where He lives, in order to listen to His Word of life, to adhere to Him Who takes away the sin of the world, to recover in Him the hope of spiritual impulse."

As the Holy Season of Lent comes upon us, may each of us seek to know the Lord and to follow Him wherever and whenever He calls us so that we may bring His Kingdom to fulfillment for us all.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

En un discurso reciente de la audiencia, el Papa Francisco habló de la peregrinación de la fe. Sus palabras merecen ser compartidas. Él dijo: "La narración del Evangelio indica las características esenciales del camino de la fe. Hay un camino de fe, y este viaje de los discípulos de todos los tiempos, el nuestro también, comenzando con la pregunta que Jesús hace a los dos que, impulsados por el Bautista, se ponen en camino para seguirlo: "¿Qué es lo que buscas?" Jn.1: 38). Es la misma pregunta que el Resucitado pregunta a María Magdalena en la mañana de Pascua: "Mujer, ¿a quién buscas?" (Juan 20:15). Cada uno de nosotros, como ser humano, busca: buscar la felicidad, buscar el amor, una vida buena y plena. Dios el Padre nos ha dado todo esto en Su Hijo Jesús.

"En esta búsqueda, el papel de un verdadero testigo, de una persona que primero realizó el viaje y se encontró con el Señor, es fundamental. En el Evangelio, Juan el Bautista es este testigo. Por esta razón, él puede dirigir a los discípulos hacia Jesús, quien los involucra en una nueva experiencia, diciendo: "Ven y ve (Jn.1: 39)"Sólo un encuentro personal con Jesús engendra un camino de fe y de discipulado. Podremos experimentar muchas cosas, lograr muchas cosas, establecer relaciones con muchas personas, pero solo la cita con Jesús, a esa hora que Dios sabe, puede dar un sentido completo a nuestra vida y hacer fructíferos nuestros planes y nuestras iniciativas. .

"... La vida de fe consiste en el deseo de poder en el Señor, y por lo tanto es una búsqueda continua del lugar donde vive. Esto significa que estamos llamados a ... reavivar el encuentro con Jesús en la oración, en la meditación de la Palabra de Dios y en la práctica de los sacramentos, para permanecer con Él y dar fruto gracias a él, a su ayuda, a su gracia. Buscar a Jesús, encontrar a Jesús, seguir a Jesús: este es el camino ... Que la Virgen María nos apoye en esta perspectiva de seguir a Jesús, de ir a vivir donde vive, para escuchar su Palabra de vida, adherirse a Aquel que quita el pecado del mundo, para recuperar en Él la esperanza del impulso espiritual ".

Al acercarse la Santa Temporada de Cuaresma, que cada uno de nosotros busque conocer al Señor y lo siga donde sea y cuando nos llame para que podamos llevar a cabo su Reino para todos nosotros.
