Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Alleluia! Christ Our Lord is Risen! Let us rejoice and be glad, Alleluia!

In addition to the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus—the sure sign of our expectant gift of life everlasting—we also celebrate as a church the Anniversary of another moment in history: the election of Pope Francis. As the Vatican newspaper, L'Osservatore Romano, proclaimed: "Five years ago, truly few had been able to foresee the Conclave's election of the Archbishop of Buenos Aires, and fewer still had expected the name Benedict XVI's Successor would choose: following the first pontifical resignation in over six centuries. Yet that name was anticipated, as some electors had suggested, and as curiously appeared in the image—repeatedly broadcast on television during the Conclave—of a man clad in a habit, kneeling in the freezing rain falling of Saint Peter's Square, around his neck a sign reading 'Pope Francis.'...

No Pontiff had ever chosen to call himself Francis, a name of profane origin which, in medieval Latin, indicated that one came from France, but which became Christian par excellence because it recalled the Saint of Assisi (who was baptized 'John') and his radicalness in the imitation of Christ...as Pope Bergoglio sought to explain to journalists three days after his election...A name which evokes the

figure of Saint Francis for three reasons: attention and closeness to the poor, preaching peace, and care for creation. These three components of the Christian message which characterize the days of the first American Pope, who is also the first non-European Pontiff in nearly 13 centuries, as well as the first Jesuit....Beyond the visible confines of the Church we hear the simple and impassioned words of a Christian who, bearing a great burden, asks us each day to pray for him."

As the Pope himself has said: "It is good to know our limitations and our weaknesses; we must be aware of them, however, not in order to despair, but to offer them to the Lord. And He helps us on the path to healing; He takes us by the hand, and never abandons us, never! God is with us and for this reason I rejoice, we rejoice today. because God is with us....We have the true and great hope in God the Father rich in mercy, Who gave us His Son to save us, and this is our joy!"

So, let us rejoice in the Gift of Life Eternal that Christ assures us belongs to all those who seek Him and follow in His footsteps. Like Him, let us trust in the Loving Kindness of the Father and proclaim by our own life: Alleluia! Christ is Risen!

May the joy and peace of the Risen Lord be with you, all ways and always, Monsignor





DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

¡Aleluya! Cristo Nuestro Señor ha resucitado! ¡Gocémonos y alegrémonos, Aleluya!

Además de la celebración de la Resurrección de Jesús, la señal segura de nuestro regalo de vida eterna, también celebramos como iglesia el aniversario de otro momento de la historia: la elección del Papa Francisco. Como el periódico del Vaticano, L'Osservatore Romano, proclamó: "Cinco años atrás, pocos habían podido prever la elección del arzobispo de Buenos Aires por parte del Cónclave, y aún menos esperaban el nombre que el sucesor de Benedicto XVI elegiría: siguiendo el primero resignación pontificia en más de seis siglos. Sin embargo, ese nombre fue anticipado, como lo sugirieron algunos electores, y apareció curiosamente en la imagen, repetidamente transmitida en televisión durante el Cónclave, de un hombre vestido de hábito, arrodillado bajo la lluvia helada que cae de la Plaza de San Pedro, al cuello un cartel que dice "Papa Francisco" ...

Ningún Pontífice había elegido llamarse a sí mismo Francisco, un nombre de origen profano que, en latín medieval, indicaba que uno provenía de Francia, pero que se volvió cristiano por excelencia porque recordaba al Santo de Asís (que fue bautizado como "Juan") y su radicalidad en la imitación de Cristo ... como el Papa Bergoglio quiso explicar a los periodistas tres días después de su elección ... Un nombre que evoca la figura de San Francisco por tres motivos: atención y cercanía a los pobres, paz y cuidado de la creación. Estos tres componentes del mensaje cristiano que caracterizan los días del primer Papa estadounidense, que es también el primer Pontífice no europeo en casi 13 siglos, así como el primer jesuita ... Más allá de los confines visibles de la Iglesia, escuchamos el simple y palabras apasionadas de un cristiano que, soportando una gran carga, nos pide cada día orar por él ".

Como el mismo Papa ha dicho: "Es bueno conocer nuestras limitaciones y nuestras debilidades; sin embargo, debemos ser conscientes de ellos, no para desesperarnos, sino para ofrecerlos al Señor. Y Él nos ayuda en el camino hacia la curación; Él nos toma de la mano, y nunca nos abandona, ¡nunca! Dios está con nosotros y por esta razón me regocijo, nos regocijamos hoy ... porque Dios está con nosotros ... Tenemos la verdadera y gran esperanza en Dios el Padre rico en misericordia, quien nos dio a Su Hijo para salvarnos, y esto es nuestra alegría!"

Entonces, regocijémonos en el Don de la Vida Eterno que Cristo nos asegura que pertenece a todos los que lo buscan y siguen Sus pasos. Como Él, confiemos en la Amorosa Bondad del Padre y proclamemos por nuestra propia vida: ¡Aleluya! ¡Cristo ha resucitado!
