Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

“I used to pray that God would feed the hungry, or do this or that, but now I pray that He will guide me to do whatever I’m supposed to do, what I can do. I used to pray for answers, but now I’m praying for strength. I used to believe that pray changes things, but now I know that prayer changes us and we change things.”—Saint Teresa of Calcutta

That statement is one of the fondest memories I have from my year and a half in Rome, working with her and her Sisters, the Missionaries of Charity. Mother was such a humble person that one could not help but feel they were in the presence of holiness incarnate. She bowed to everyone she met, with her hands folded in prayerful fashion; not out of deference to the individual but out of reverence to the “spark of the Divine” that she believed resided within each of them. She would remind her sisters daily that they did NOT bring Jesus to the poor, rather they discovered Jesus in the distressing disguise of the poor to whom they were sent to serve. That is the reason why she taught us the prayer that I included in last week’s bulletin; asking each of us to recite it daily before we began our works of mercy; and to conclude each day with it before we retired to rest.

Saint Teresa had a particular care for this country. She had a particular concern for the poverty of spirit that she felt pervades the society in which we live. For her, we needed to pray for a deeper awareness of Who God is for us and within us so that our daily routines would not be self-centered but other-centered to the degree that no matter how challenged we might become, we would never forget that Jesus was standing with us and ready to assist all those who acknowledged their need for Him.

It was no surprise to me to learn that Saint Teresa saw the Church as the Communion of Saints and Angels. She believed that only by seeing each other as an expression of the living, loving presence of the Father could we ever hope to find His Son, Jesus, in our midst. She believed that we are each a God-bearer, like His Blessed Mother, Mary Immaculate, who have been asked by Him to manifest His loving kindness to all whom we meet. In that way she was certain that we could preserve ourselves from sinfulness and come to a better awareness of the mission in life that Saint Paul says we are each called—life on high in Christ Jesus, Our Lord. (see Titus 3:7)

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor: Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma:

1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556. 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana.

3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

"Solía orar para que Dios alimentara a los hambrientos, o hiciera esto o aquello, pero ahora oro para que me guíe a hacer lo que se supone que debo hacer, lo que puedo hacer. Solía orar por respuestas, pero ahora estoy rezando por fortaleza. Solía creer que orar cambia las cosas, pero ahora sé que la oración nos cambia y cambiamos las cosas." - Santa Teresa de Calcuta

Esa declaración es uno de los mejores recuerdos que tengo de mi año y medio en Roma, trabajando con ella y sus Hermanas, las Misioneras de la Caridad. La madre era una persona tan humilde que uno no podía evitar sentir que estaban en presencia de la encarnación de la santidad. Hizo una reverencia a todos los que se encontró, con las manos cruzadas en actitud de oración; no por deferencia hacia el individuo sino por reverencia a la "chispa de Lo Divino" que ella creía que residía dentro de cada uno de ellos. Recordaba a sus hermanas todos los días que NO llevaron a Jesús a los pobres, sino que descubrieron a Jesús disfrazado de los pobres a los que fueron enviados a servir. Esa es la razón por la que ella nos enseñó la oración que incluí en el boletín de la semana pasada; pidiéndole a cada uno de nosotros que lo recite a diario antes de comenzar nuestras obras de misericordia; y para concluir cada día con él antes de que nos retiremos a descansar.

Santa Teresa tenía un cuidado especial para este país. Ella tenía una preocupación particular por la pobreza de espíritu que sentía que impregna la sociedad en la que vivimos. Para ella, necesitábamos rezar por una conciencia más profunda de quién es Dios para nosotros y dentro de nosotros para que nuestras rutinas diarias no sean egocéntricas sino centradas en el otro al grado de que no importa cuán desafiados podamos llegar a ser, nunca lo haríamos. olviden que Jesús estaba con nosotros y listo para ayudar a todos aquellos que reconocieron su necesidad de él.

No me sorprendió saber que Santa Teresa veía la Iglesia como la Comunión de los Santos y los Ángeles. Ella creía que solo al verse unos a otros como una expresión de la presencia viva y amorosa del Padre, podríamos esperar encontrar a su Hijo, Jesús, en medio de nosotros. Ella creía que todos somos portadores de Dios, como Su Santísima Madre, María Inmaculada, a quien Él le ha pedido que manifieste Su bondad amorosa a todos los que encontremos. De esa manera ella estaba segura de que podíamos preservarnos de la pecaminosidad y llegar a tener una mejor conciencia de la misión en la vida que San Pablo dice que todos somos llamados: la vida en lo alto en Cristo Jesús, Nuestro Señor. (ver Tito 3: 7)

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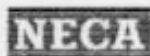
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
