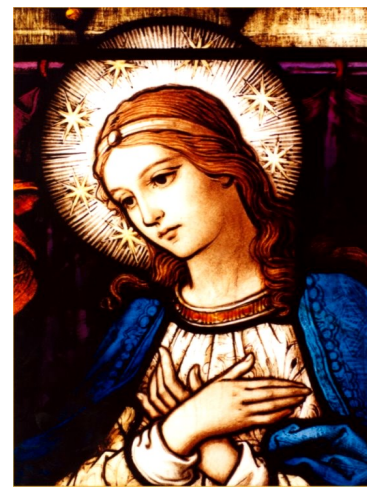

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

The prayer intention of Pope Francis for the month of August is that “any far-reaching decisions of economics and politicians may protect the family as one of the resources of humanity.” He proceeded to explain the intention in this manner: “Today’s rhythm of life, stress, pressure at work, and also the little attention paid by institutions, could put families in danger....It is not enough to talk about the family’s importance; it is necessary to promote concrete means to develop the role in society with a good family policy.”

As part of his pending trip to Ireland the Pope will participate in the “Festival of Families” to celebrate what he terms the central role of the family in any society. The Pope judges the family to be the backbone of intergenerational solidarity and of passing on basic human values from one generation to the next. He sees each family as the means to identify values that hold us all together—values that promote justice, tolerance, caring and outreach to our neighbors and our world.

One of the many blessings of my life has been my own family. We had learned how to stand by one another in my early childhood years in Baltimore, Maryland; when a sister of mine was victimized by a local predator. When the family was transferred around the country, due

to dad’s work responsibilities for the Railroad, we learned how to meet new friends and remain in touch with those who had become a close knit part of our extended family of friends. We also learned that there is no difference between us and those of another color, race, or economic background. Many were the times that our parents held backyard “picnics” to invite friends and relations to share in the simple joys of life and the abundance common blessings can bring.

As our modern society continues to emphasize the individual and continues to prize self-centeredness as a goal to be achieved at all costs, I think we do well to hold within our hearts the words of Pope Francis regarding our individual family relationships and the universal family of humankind to which we all belong. By caring for and reaching out to one another in friendly concern and loving kindness, we can all learn to appreciate the common bonds that unite us and celebrate the difference that ethnicity and cultural background brings forth from us. Let us hold others dear to us as treasures to be protected and sisters and brothers in the Lord of Life.

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

La intención de oración del Papa Francisco para el mes de agosto es que "cualquier decisión de largo alcance de la economía y los políticos pueda proteger a la familia como uno de los recursos de la humanidad". Él procedió a explicar la intención de esta manera: "El ritmo actual de la vida, el estrés, la presión en el trabajo, y también la poca atención que prestan las instituciones, podrían poner a las familias en peligro No es suficiente hablar sobre la importancia de la familia; es necesario promover medios concretos para desarrollar el rol en la sociedad con una buena política familiar. "

Como parte de su viaje pendiente a Irlanda, el Papa participará en el "Festival de las Familias" para celebrar lo que él llama el rol central de la familia en cualquier sociedad. El Papa considera que la familia es la columna vertebral de la solidaridad intergeneracional y de transmitir los valores humanos básicos de una generación a otra. También aprendimos que no hay diferencia entre nosotros y los de otro color, raza o origen económico. Muchas fueron las veces que nuestros padres celebraron "picnics" en el patio trasero para invitar a amigos y parientes a compartir las alegrías simples de la vida y la abundancia que las bendiciones comunes pueden brindar.

A medida que nuestra sociedad moderna continúa enfatizando al individuo y continúa premiando el egocentrismo como un objetivo que debe lograrse a toda costa, creo que debemos mantener en nuestros corazones las palabras del Papa Francisco con respecto a nuestras relaciones familiares individuales y la familia universal. de la humanidad a la que todos pertenecemos. Cuidando y acercándose unos a otros en preocupación amistosa y bondad amorosa, todos podemos aprender a apreciar los lazos comunes que nos unen y celebrar la diferencia que la etnia y el origen cultural nos brindan.
