Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Last week when I was celebrating Reconciliation with church members at St. Mary, I was wished many blessings for the present Holy Season of Christmastide. I was asked by a number of people whether or not I would be going home to visit with family and responded in the negative since my parents have both been born into the "Land Beyond Time" in the Kingdom of Heaven. I did respond that my family was now here, within the two parish communities of Saint Mary and Saint Ambrose.

Since my return to Anderson five years ago, I have considered myself particularly blessed among the priests of the diocese for being given the opportunity to retire from the community to which I was first assigned in 1978 as a newly ordained priest. Much has changed in that time, particularly within me by virtue of the years of priestly life that God has granted.

One of the lasting memories of my vocation comes from Saint Charles parish in Peru, Indiana. It was my second assignment in ministry. There was a family there comprised of fourteen children and a mom and dad that touched my heart deeply. Their youngest child was challenged by Downs Syndrome. She seemed to me to be the star of the family for everyone was devoted to her

care. I was 'adopted' by the parents into the inner family circle and spent many a day with them. We shared many blessings and addressed many challenges together as a family. I was given the nickname, Sonny, by the family (and number fifteen by the siblings since they called each other by number of birth order, not by name).

Two years after being there, I was chosen by Bishop George Fulcher to go to Rome for a Doctorate in Canon Law. "Mom" and "Dad" held a special farewell party for me and gave me a travel bag for the pending journey. "Dad" told me, "Sonny, take this with you to remind you that as long as you live what you preach, people will follow you; but if the day ever comes that you stop doing that, your life will be worthless." I have never forgotten those words of wisdom.

We are celebrating the Liturgical Time of Year that assures each of us that we are worth it! It assures us that God loved us and the world enough to become one with us and teach us how to become one with Him. May your efforts to do that bring Happiness and Peace to your little corner of the world. One by one we will built the Kingdom of the "Land Beyond Time."

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

La semana pasada, cuando estaba celebrando la Reconciliación con los miembros de la iglesia en Santa María, se me desearon muchas bendiciones para la presente temporada santa de Christmastide. Varias personas me preguntaron si iría o no a mi hogar para visitar a mi familia y respondieron negativamente, ya que mis padres han nacido en la "Tierra más allá del tiempo" en el Reino de los Cielos. Respondí que mi familia ahora estaba aquí, dentro de las dos comunidades parroquiales de Santa María y San Ambrosio.

Desde mi regreso a Anderson hace cinco años, me considero especialmente bendecido entre los sacerdotes de la diócesis por tener la oportunidad de retirarme de la comunidad a la que me asignaron por primera vez en 1978 como sacerdote recién ordenado. Mucho ha cambiado en ese tiempo, particularmente dentro de mí en virtud de los años de vida sacerdotal que Dios ha otorgado.

Uno de los recuerdos duraderos de mi vocación proviene de la parroquia de Saint Charles en Perú, Indiana. Fue mi segunda misión en el ministerio. Allí había una familia compuesta por catorce hijos y una mamá y un papá que me conmovieron profundamente. Su hijo más pequeño fue desafiado por el síndrome de Down. Me pareció que era la estrella de la familia porque todos estaban dedicados a su cuidado. Fui "adoptado" por los padres en el círculo familiar interno y pasé muchos días con ellos. Compartimos muchas bendiciones y abordamos muchos desafios juntos como familia. Me dieron el apodo, Sonny, por la familia (y el número quince por los hermanos, ya que se llamaron por número de orden de nacimiento, no por nombre).

Dos años después de estar allí, fui elegido por el obispo George Fulcher para ir a Roma para un doctorado en derecho canónico. "Mamá" y "Papá" celebraron una fiesta de despedida especial para mí y me dieron una bolsa de viaje para el viaje pendiente. "Papá" me dijo: "Sonny, llévate esto contigo para recordarte que mientras vivas lo que predicas, la gente te seguirá; pero si alguna vez llega el día en que dejes de hacer eso, tu vida no valdrá nada". Nunca he olvidado esas palabras de sabiduría.

¡Celebramos la época del año Litrugical que nos asegura a cada uno de nosotros que valemos la pena! Nos asegura que Dios nos amó y al mundo lo suficiente como para ser uno con nosotros y enseñarnos cómo volvernos uno con él. Que sus esfuerzos para hacer eso traigan Felicidad y Paz a su pequeño rincón del mundo. Uno por uno construiremos el Reino de la "Tierra más allá del tiempo".
