Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

One of the greatest men I have known in my life was Jim Albregts. He was the next door neighbor of Bishop Higi's secretary, Jerriann, and lived in Lafayette, Indiana, all his life. Jim had seven brothers and seven sisters with whom he grew up on the family farm outside of Lafayette. He worked for Purdue University for 42 years and was a devoted jogger and bicyclist. He was a good man! I have fond memories of him bicycling or running past my residence in Lafayette and always stopping for a moment (if on his bike) to greet my dog, Lilly; or call out "have a blessed day" as he jogged past the two of us. He was a dedicated Catholic who served at Saint Boniface church in Lafayette and always seemed to make the space around him a little bit better.

Jim died from Alzheimer's disease in February 2018. The disease had claimed his memories at least one year before claiming his life. Just like my dad, Jim lost contact with the world around him and lived in the subconscious state of his past, confidently unaware of others around him but sustained by an inner determination to try and live his life as best he knew how. With his passing a personal Prayer Book was discovered at his bedside. Within it was a prayer entitled "Good Night, O Lord."

Here is the text of the prayer: "Before I go to sleep, O Lord...I want to say this prayer... That You will always keep me in...Your kind and loving care...That

You will let my body rest...And let my mind relax...And fill my dreams with holy thoughts...Instead of worldly facts...I ask that You forgive me for...My failures of today...And give me all the grace I need...To live a better way...Watch over me tonight, O Lord...And in my heart instill...The fervor and the constancy...To do Your holy will...I want to follow You and grow...More worthy in Your sight...O Lord, please listen to my prayer...And hear me say Good-night."

I have kept that prayer on my bedside stand and it is usually the last thing I pray before falling asleep. There is a rhythmic restfulness in its verses that brings a sense of peaceful comfort to troubled days and helps worries find a space in the Heart of the Savior so that the heart of His servant is not disquieted by anxiety. I would suggest that you consider making it your own. If Jim is any witness to its last effects, your own life will find time to stop and greet others or at least wish them well as you pass them by during your daily routines.

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor: Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma: 1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556. 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana. 3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:


Uno de los mejores hombres que he conocido en mi vida fue Jim Albregts. Era el vecino de al lado de la secretaria del obispo Higi, Jerriann, y vivió en Lafayette, Indiana, toda su vida. Jim tenía siete hermanos y siete hermanas con quienes creció en la granja familiar fuera de Lafayette. Trabajó para la Universidad de Purdue durante 42 años y fue un devoto corredor y ciclista. ¡El fue un buen hombre! Tengo buenos recuerdos de él andando en bicicleta o corriendo más allá de mi residencia en Lafayette y siempre parando por un momento (en su bicicleta) para saludar a mi perro, Lilly; o grita "Que tengas un buen día" mientras pasaba junto a nosotros dos. Era un católico dedicado que servía en la iglesia de Saint Boniface en Lafayette y siempre parecía hacer que el espacio a su alrededor fuera un poco mejor.

Jim murió de la enfermedad de Alzheimer en febrero de 2018. La enfermedad había reclamado sus recuerdos al menos un año antes de reclamar su vida. Al igual que mi padre, Jim perdió el contacto con el mundo que lo rodeaba y vivió en el estado subconsciente de su pasado, desconfiando de los demás que lo rodeaban, pero sostenido por una determinación interna de intentar vivir su vida de la mejor manera posible. Con su paso se descubrió un Libro de Oración personal junto a su cama. Dentro de ella había una oración titulada "Buenas noches, Señor".

Aquí está el texto de la oración: "Antes de irme a dormir, oh Señor ... quiero decir esta oración ... Que siempre me mantendrás en ... Tu amable y amoroso cuidado ... Que dejarás que mi cuerpo descanse ... Y que mi mente relajada ... Y llena mis sueños con pensamientos santos ... En lugar de hechos mundanos ... Te pido que me perdones por ... Mis fallas de hoy ... Y dame toda la gracia que necesito ... Para vivir mejor ... Cuídame esta noche, oh Señor ... Y en mi corazón, infunde ... El fervor y la constancia ... Para hacer Tu santa voluntad ... Quiero seguirte y crecer ... Más digno a tus ojos ... Oh Señor, por favor escucha mi oración ... Y escúchame decir buenas noches ."

He mantenido esa oración en mi mesita de noche y generalmente es lo último que rezo antes de quedarme dormido. Hay un descanso rítmico en sus versos que brinda una sensación de comodidad pacífica a los días turbulentos y ayuda a encontrar un espacio en el Corazón del Salvador para que el corazón de Su siervo no se sienta inquieto por la ansiedad. Te sugiero que consideres hacerlo tuyo. Si Jim es testigo de sus últimos efectos, su propia vida encontrará tiempo para detenerse y saludar a los demás o, al menos, desearles lo mejor a medida que los pase durante sus rutinas diarias.
