Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Pope Francis has been a source of inspiration to the world since he began serving the Church as the Supreme Pontiff seven years ago. Recently he addressed the need for further conversion of the heart for us all. "An insatiable greed makes all human history, even today, when, paradoxically, a few dine luxuriantly while all too many go without the daily bread needed to survive.

"Bethlehem is the turning point that alters the course of history. There God, in the 'house of bread' (the meaning of the name Bethlehem) is born in a manger. It is as if he wanted to say: 'Here I am, as your food.' He does not take, but gives us to eat; He does not give us a mere thing, but His very Self...By feeding on Him, the Bread of Life, we can be reborn in love, and break the spiral of grasping and greed. From the 'house of bread' Jesus brings us back home so that we can become God's family, brothers and sisters to our neighbors....we understand that the Food of Life is not riches but love, not gluttony but charity, not ostentation but simplicity.

"The face of God has been revealed in a human face. It did not appear as an angel, but in one man, born in a specific time and place. By His Incarnation, the Son of God tells us that salvation comes through love,

acceptance, respect for the poor humanity of ours, which we all share in a great variety of races, languages, and cul tures. Yet all of us are brothers and sisters in humanity!

Our differences, then, are not a detriment or a danger; they are a source of richness. As when an artist is about to make a mosaic, it is better to have tiles of many colors available, rather than just a few!"

The words of Pope Francis ought to give us pause to reflect on the fact that there is no distinction between us when we see ourselves as children of a Loving Father. There is no need to separate ourselves one from another. We are called to be one in the Body of Christ and to affirm the value of each other by realizing that if we stand alone, we stand incomplete. We are only made whole when we chose to take part in the fullness of life that is found in our togetherness. In our unity we discover the gift of peace that Christ left for all those who, take and eat of the Bread of Life, take and drink from the Cup of Salvation.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

El Papa Francisco ha sido una fuente de inspiración para el mundo desde que comenzó a servir a la Iglesia como el Sumo Pontífice hace siete años. Recientemente abordó la necesidad de una mayor conversión del corazón para todos nosotros. "Una avaricia insaciable hace que toda la historia humana, incluso dia, cuando, paradójicamente, algunos coman exuberantemente, mientras que muchos se quedan sin el pan diario necesario para sobrevivir.

"Belén es el punto de inflexión que altera el curso de la historia. Allí, Dios, en la "casa del pan" (el significado del nombre Belén) nace en un pesebre. Es como si quisiera decir: 'Aquí estoy, como tu comida'. No toma, sino que nos da de comer; Él no nos da una mera cosa, sino su propio Ser ... Al alimentarnos de Él, el Pan de la Vida, podemos renacer en el amor y romper la espiral de la codicia y la codicia. Desde la 'casa del pan', Jesús nos trae de vuelta a casa para que podamos convertirnos en la familia de Dios, hermanos y hermanas para nuestros vecinos ... entendemos que el Alimento de la Vida no es riqueza sino amor, no gula, sino caridad, no ostentación sino simplicidad.

"El rostro de Dios ha sido revelado en un rostro humano. No apareció como un ángel, sino en un hombre, nacido en un tiempo y lugar específicos. Por Su encarnación, el Hijo de Dios nos dice que la salvación viene a través del amor, la aceptación, el respeto por nuestra pobre humanidad, que todos compartimos en una gran variedad de razas, idiomas y culturas. ¡Sin embargo, todos nosotros somos hermanos y hermanas en la humanidad! Nuestras diferencias, entonces, no son un detrimento o un peligro; son una fuente de riqueza. Como cuando un artista está a punto de hacer un mosaico, ¡es mejor tener mosaicos de muchos colores disponibles, en lugar de unos pocos!

Las palabras del Papa Francisco nos deberían hacer una pausa para reflexionar sobre el hecho de que no hay distinción entre nosotros cuando nos vemos a nosotros mismos como hijos de un Padre amoroso. No hay necesidad de separarnos unos de otros. Estamos llamados a ser uno en el Cuerpo de Cristo y a afirmar el valor de los demás al darnos cuenta de que si estamos solos, estamos incompletos. Solo nos sentimos completos cuando elegimos participar en la plenitud de vida que se encuentra en nuestra unidad. En nuestra unidad, descubrimos el don de paz que Cristo dejó para todos aquellos que, toman y comen del Pan de la Vida, toman y beben de la Copa de la Salvación.
