Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

As most of us are aware, Pope Francis visited Central America in mid-January for World youth Day. Here are some excerpts from his closing Mass in Panama.

"'Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.' (Lk.4:20-21) With these words, the Gospel presents the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. It started in the synagogue that saw Him grow up...It was an important moment in the life of the Master: the child who was educated and grew up in that community, stood up and took the floor to proclaim and put into action God's Dream. A word proclaimed only as a future promise, but now, on the lips of Jesus alone, could be spoken in the present tense, as it became a reality: 'Today is has been fulfilled.'

"Jesus reveals the now of God, Who comes to meet us and call us to take part in His now of 'proclaiming good news to the poor...bringing liberty to captives and recovering of sight to the blind, setting at liberty those who are oppressed, announcing the year of favor of the Lord.' (Lk.4: 18-19)...It is a merciful love that does not wait for ideal or perfect situations to show itself, nor does it accept excuses for its appearance. It is God's time that makes every situation and place both right and proper. In Jesus the promised future begins and becomes life.

"...You, dear young people, are not the future. We like to say, 'you are the future.' No, you are the present...you are the now of God. He invites you and calls you in your communities and cities to go out and find your grandparents, your elders; to stand up and with them to speak out and realize the dream that the Lord has dreamed for you. No tomorrow, now, for wherever your reassure is now, there will you heart also be (see Mt.6:21).

"...For Jesus there is no meantime, but only a merciful love that wants to enter into and win over our hearts. He wants to be our treasure...He is concrete, close, real love today. He is festive joy born of opting for and taking part in the miraculous draught of hope and charity, solidarity and fraternity, despite the paralyzed and paralyzing gaze born of fear and exclusion, speculation and manipulation...As in the synagogue of Nazareth, the Lord stands up again among us his friends and acquaintances, He takes the book and says to us, 'Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

May the Spirit of the Lord give each of us the grace to stand and respond to the call of Christ so that His message of justice and peace may be maintained throughout our world by our very works and words.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Como la mayoría de nosotros sabemos, el Papa Francisco visitó América Central a mediados de enero para el Día Mundial de la Juventud. Aquí hay algunos extractos de su misa de clausura en Panamá. "Hoy hemos cumplido con esta escritura en tu audiencia" (Lc.4: 20-21). Con estas palabras, el Evangelio presenta el comienzo del ministerio público de Jesús. Comenzó en la sinagoga que lo vio crecer ... Fue un momento importante en la vida del Maestro: el niño que fue educado y creció en esa comunidad, se levantó y tomó la palabra para proclamar y poner en acción el Sueño de Dios. Una palabra proclamada solo como una promesa futura, pero ahora, solo en los labios de Jesús, se puede pronunciar en tiempo presente, ya que se convirtió en una realidad: "Hoy se ha cumplido".

"Jesús revela el ahora de Dios, que viene a reunirse con nosotros y nos llama a participar en su ahora de 'proclamar buenas nuevas a los pobres ... llevar la libertad a los cautivos y recuperar la vista de los ciegos, poniendo en libertad a los oprimidos". , anunciando el año de favor del Señor. '(Lk.4: 18-19) ... Es un amor misericordioso que no espera a que aparezcan situaciones ideales o perfectas, ni acepta excusas para su aparición. Es el momento de Dios lo que hace que cada situación y lugar sean correctos y apropiados. En Jesús el futuro prometido comienza y se convierte en vida.

- "... Ustedes, queridos jóvenes, no son el futuro. Nos gusta decir, 'tú eres el futuro'. No, eres el presente ... eres el ahora de Dios. Él te invita y te llama en tus comunidades y ciudades para salir y encontrar a tus abuelos, tus mayores; para ponerse de pie y con ellos para hablar y realizar el sueño que el Señor ha soñado para ti. No mañana, ahora, donde esté su tranquilidad ahora, también estará su corazón (ver Mt.6: 21).
- "... Para Jesús no hay entretanto, solo un amor misericordioso que quiere entrar y ganar nuestros corazones. Él quiere ser nuestro tesoro ... Él es concreto, cercano, verdadero amor hoy. Es una alegría festiva nacida de optar y participar en el proyecto milagroso de esperanza y caridad, solidaridad y fraternidad, a pesar de la mirada paralizada y paralizadora nacida del miedo y la exclusión, la especulación y la manipulación ... Como en la sinagoga de Nazaret, el Señor se pone de pie. De nuevo entre nosotros, sus amigos y conocidos, Él toma el libro y nos dice: "Hoy se cumplen estas Escrituras en su audiencia".
