Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

It is with joy that I come to Anderson to spend the semester with you all here at St. Ambrose and St. Mary parishes. My name is Elliot Zak, and I am a seminarian for the Diocese of Lafayette. This year of studies is my second year of theology. While I am normally at Mundelein Seminary near Chicago, this semester all the students in my class and I have been sent back to our respective dioceses to live beside diocesan priests in order to see what the practical day-to-day life of a priest looks like. Thank you to Msgr. Sell, Fr. Shine, and all of you for your generosity in welcoming me to the parish.

The third of four children, I grew up in Lafayette as a member of St. Boniface Church. After high school, I went to Purdue University to study Electrical Engineering. It was during my time at Purdue, that I began to spend more and more time in the chapel in front of the Blessed Sacrament. While admittedly I originally spent more time pleading for grades than speaking heart-to-heart with Christ, little by little I began to become aware of the Divine Presence in that little, Eucharistic Host. It soon dawned on me that Jesus really did and does follow through on His words and promises. When He said at the end of the Gospel of Matthew “behold, I

am with you always, until the end of the age” (Mt 28: 20), He keeps that promise in a particular way through His Presence in the Eucharist. He truly is the “living bread that came down from Heaven” (Jn 6:51). And when He commands us to abide in Him (cf. Jn 15:1-10), He makes this possible in many ways, but most especially in the great gift of the Eucharist.

Upon realizing the immensity of this great gift of His very Flesh and Blood, I soon also became aware of the reality that my life would have to change from that moment onward. When the fire of Divine Love comes into our hearts and souls, it inflames them, incorporating them into the Divine Fire. The Love of Christ urges us to constant conversion, to seek His face always in order to realize the great love that God has for us. And it is precisely this great truth which I hope to bear witness to throughout my time here in Anderson and as a priest of Jesus Christ. Let’s fall in love with Love Himself, ever-present in that tiny white Host.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Con alegría vengo a Anderson para pasar el semestre con todos ustedes aquí en las parroquias de St. Ambrose y St. Mary. Me llamo Elliot Zak y soy seminarista de la Diócesis de Lafayette. Este año de estudios es mi segundo año de teología. Aunque normalmente estoy en el Seminario Mundelein cerca de Chicago, este semestre todos los estudiantes de mi clase y yo hemos sido enviados de regreso a nuestras respectivas diócesis para vivir al lado de los sacerdotes diocesanos a fin de ver cómo es la práctica vida cotidiana de un sacerdote. Gracias a Msgr. Sell, Padre Shine, y todos ustedes por su generosidad al darme la bienvenida a las parroquias.

El tercero de cuatro hijos, crecí en Lafayette como miembro de la Iglesia de San Bonifacio. Después de la secundaria, fui a la Universidad de Purdue para estudiar Ingeniería Eléctrica. Fue durante mi tiempo en Purdue, que comencé a pasar más y más tiempo en la capilla frente al Santísimo Sacramento. Aunque hay que admitir que originalmente pasé más tiempo pidiendo calificaciones que hablando de corazón a corazón con Cristo, poco a poco comencé a tomar conciencia de la Presencia Divina en esa pequeña Hostia Eucarística. Pronto me di cuenta de que Jesús realmente cumplió y cumple sus palabras y promesas. Cuando dijo al final del Evangelio de Mateo "he aquí, estoy contigo siempre, hasta el final de la era" (Mt 28:20), Él mantiene esa promesa de una manera particular a través de Su Presencia en la Eucaristía.
