Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

There are only Twelve Days of Lent Remaining! The Sacred Triduum is the Solemn Closing of this Holy Season. The word 'Triduum" literally means the last three days—Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. These days celebrate the Passion, Crucifixion, Death and Burial of Our Lord Jesus Christ. This fortnight is our most sacred time of the Liturgical calendar year. That is because of the fact that without the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus, we would still be awaiting the Salvation by Our God.

It is the gift of Salvation that we are called to remember and celebrate as a community of Faith. Part of the reason why all the statues and the Crucifix are either covered or draped during these days is to help us visually focus on the Stations of the Cross, the Road to Salvation that was won for us by Our Savior. Each year has been a privilege for me to help cover or drape these artifacts of piety. We are, indeed, fortunate at both parishes that we have the renderings of the Stations of the Cross that we do. They help us visualize the actual steps of Jesus as we call to mind those who sought to help, those who were forced to help, and those who refused to help Him approach the Altar of the Cross.

Another mean of assistance for us to prepare for the coming Solemn Days is our parish Communal Penance Service on Wednesday, April 10. There will be two opportunities to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation through the assistance of at least five different priests that day. The first service is to be held at Saint Mary church beginning at 1 PM. The time of the service is primarily for the benefit of the school children attending Holy Cross School. However, it is also open for anyone in either parish to attend.

The second service will begin at 6 PM at Saint Ambrose church. There will also be at least five priests assisting in the celebration of the sacrament. Everyone is invited to come and receive the Grace of Forgiveness. Each and every one of us is granted a time and place in which to identify more deeply with the Spirit of Mercy that we encounter in the wonderful sacrament of Reconciliation. It is a time to remind ourselves not only of what Jesus accomplished for us in His Passion and Death; but it is also a moment in which to receive a foretaste of the Heavenly Celebration of God's loving kindness.

May each of you find an opportunity this coming week to share in the wonder and the spiritual peace that can be yours,



How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:


¡Solo quedan doce días de Cuaresma! El Triduo Sagrado es el cierre solemne de esta temporada santa. La palabra "Triduo" significa literalmente los últimos tres días: Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo y Sábado Santo. Estos días celebran la Pasión, la Crucifixión, la Muerte y el Entierro de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Esta quincena es nuestro tiempo más sagrado del año calendario litúrgico. Esto se debe al hecho de que sin la Pasión, la Muerte y la Resurrección de Jesús, todavía estaríamos esperando la Salvación de Nuestro Dios.

Es el don de la salvación que estamos llamados a recordar y celebrar como una comunidad de fe.
