Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

ALLELUIA! Christ is Risen! ALLELUIA! Death is conquered! ALLELUIA! With this ancient Prayer of Praise the Church throughout the world resounds with the message of Salvation and the Gift of Eternal Life that is promised to all who profess on their lips and believe in their hearts that Jesus Christ is Lord, raised to glory by God the Father (see Romans10:9).

The glory of Lent is meant to be proclaimed through the prayer-filled actions of our heart. This is not a time to say to ourselves "Thank God THAT'S done, now I can get back to my usual things." Hopefully we have been so motivated by the experience of spiritual renewal from Lent that we can respond with anticipated joy to the Lord's call to come, follow Him (Mt.4:18). The Holy Season of Lent can teach us how to trust in the Lord and give over to Him all that estranges us from His Life and Love. With 'hearts on fire" (Lk.24:32) from joyful hope, we are now TO BE disciples of the Lord and to carry His message to all those to whom He sends us and all those who cross our path.

The most recent issue of <u>Reader's Digest</u> contains a section on the meaning of success. One of the contributors for that article, Trisha Gonsalez from Jacksonville,

Florida defines success "In the words attributed to Ralph Waldo Emerson: 'Success is to know even one life has breathed easier because you have lived." THAT is success to me!" I sincerely believe that each one of us needs to take a moment each morning, perhaps before we even get out of bed, to pray to God that He gives us the sustained grace of the heart to do SOMETHING for one other person during the hours we are awake. If we do that, then, perhaps, when it comes to return to bed for the restful renewal of body and spirit, we will be able to recall the wonder of God in the day we have just finished. Then we might be able to say to ourselves, "Thanks be to God for that moment of Grace. Thanks be to God for that gift of wonder and willingness to do something for the sake of one other person. Thanks be to God for the Faith that teaches me to say YES to the Lord in every single moment of life."

Alleluia! Christ is Risen! Alleluia! Death is conquered! Alleluia! Never be afraid to remember the love of God. Never be unwilling to trust His Guidance. Never fail to say to yourself: this day God gives me life; may I find its wonder and share its blessing for the sake of at least one other heart!
