Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

Last week I spoke about the renovations that are being completed for both parishes. Since then I need to explain a matter of clarification. A concern was voiced to the Bishop's Office that no consideration was given to seeking a "Dovetail" recommendation to the diocese for the repair work that is being done at St. Mary church. That matter is not correct. Allow me to clarify a point in regards to the diocesan classification of "Dovetail" for any Fruitful Harvest campaign within the diocese.

Parishes are invited to apply for "Dovetail" for various needs or projects that are planned, except for the reduction of debt. However, in order to be fully considered for a "Dovetail" a parish MUST guarantee One Hundred Percent payment of their assigned goal. All monies that are given by parishioners from parishes that are dovetailed goes first to the complete payment of their goal. Only funds that remain in other contributions are then applied directly to the parish for the accepted purpose. Because of the fact that in the two most recent Fruitful Harvest campaigns neither parish in Anderson was able to meet One Hundred Percent of their assigned goal, neither parish Finance Council thought it would be beneficial to apply for "Dovetail" status. As matters stand, we MUST fulfill Ninety Percent of the assigned goal for the present Fruitful Harvest Campaign. If at either parish we are able to pay One Hundred Percent of

that goal then that parish would receive a Ten Percent Rebate. Both Finance Councils felt that would be a better benefit for either parish to consider.

It is for that reason that I have decided NOT to apply for "Dovetail" status and to accept the permission of the bishop to seek a direct financial appeal for the works that are in progress at both sites.

At St. Ambrose we have had a particular blessing come our way in regards to the roof project. An anonymous donor has offered a "Matching Fund" of up to Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) towards the completion of the roof. What that means is that for every dollar donated up to that amount, the parish will receive a matching amount. So if all parishioners joined together and donated an amount totaling Seventy-five Thousand Dollars, the parish would actually receive One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars for the project! That, indeed, would be a blessing for us all.

So, let me, once again, ask you to consider donating as best you are able to assist in the works that are being undertaken at both parishes so that the future generations of Catholics in the Anderson area may continue to enjoy churches worthy of God's Worship and our Thanksgiving.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

La semana pasada hablé sobre las renovaciones que se están realizando para ambas parroquias. Desde entonces necesito explicar una cuestión de aclaración. Se expresó una inquietud ante la Oficina del Obispo de que no se había considerado la posibilidad de solicitar una recomendación "Dovetail" a la diócesis para el trabajo de reparación que se está realizando en la iglesia de Santa María. Ese asunto no es correcto. Permítame aclarar un punto con respecto a la clasificación diocesana de "Cola de Milano" para cualquier campaña de Fruitful Harvest dentro de la diócesis.

Se invita a las parroquias a solicitar "Cola de milano" para diversas necesidades o proyectos que están planificados, excepto por la reducción de la deuda. Sin embargo, para ser considerado completamente como un "Dovetail", una parroquia DEBE garantizar el cien por ciento de pago de su objetivo asignado. Todos los fondos que son entregados por los feligreses de parroquias que están encajados van primero al pago completo de su objetivo. Solo los fondos que permanecen en otras contribuciones se aplican directamente a la parroquia para el propósito aceptado. Debido al hecho de que en las dos campañas más recientes de Fruitful Harvest ninguna de las parroquias de Anderson pudo cumplir el cien por ciento de su objetivo asignado, ninguna de las parroquias del Consejo de Finanzas pensó que sería beneficioso solicitar el estado de "Cola de milano". Tal como están las cosas, DEBEMOS cumplir el noventa por ciento de la meta asignada para la presente Campaña de cosecha fructífera. Si en cualquiera de las parroquias podemos pagar el cien por ciento de esa meta, esa parroquia recibirá un reembolso del diez por ciento. Ambos Consejos de Finanzas consideraron que sería un mejor beneficio para cualquiera de las parroquias a considerar.

Es por esa razón que he decidido NO solicitar el estatus de "Cola de milano" y aceptar el permiso del obispo para buscar una apelación financiera directa para las obras en curso en ambos sitios.

En St. Ambrose hemos recibido una bendición particular en lo que respecta al proyecto del techo. Un donante anónimo ha ofrecido un "Fondo de contrapartida" de hasta setenta y cinco mil dólares (\$ 75,000.00) para completar el techo. Lo que eso significa es que por cada dólar donado hasta esa cantidad, la parroquia recibirá una cantidad equivalente. Entonces, si todos los feligreses se unieran y donaran una cantidad total de setenta y cinco mil dólares, ¡la parroquia realmente recibiría ciento cincuenta mil dólares para el proyecto! Eso, de hecho, sería una bendición para todos nosotros.

Entonces, permítame, una vez más, pedirle que considere donar lo mejor que pueda para ayudar en las obras que se están realizando en ambas parroquias para que las generaciones futuras de católicos en el área de Anderson puedan continuar disfrutando de iglesias dignas de la adoración de Dios. y nuestra acción de gracias.
