Dear Brothers and Sister in the Lord:

In mid-May at the Vatican, Pope Francis ordained nineteen new priests for the Church Universal. His homily and personal reflections during the Mass offer a keen insight into the gift of Holy Orders for the church today. Allow me to share some of them.

"Our sons have been called to the order of priests. It will do us all good to consider carefully the position to which they are to be promoted in the Church....Jesus Christ chose some of His followers to carry out publicly in the Church a priestly ministry in His name on behalf of mankind, continuing His personal mission as Teacher, as Priest, as Shepherd.

"Indeed, for this reason He was sent by the Father, and He in turn sent into the world the Apostles, and then the Bishops and their successors. Priests are co-workers of the order of Bishops, to whom they are joined in the priestly office and are called to serve the People of God....They are called to be molded into the likeness of Christ, the Supreme and Eternal Priest...sharing in the priesthood of their Bishop, to preach the Gospel, sustain God's people, and preside at the rites of worship, above all the celebration of the Lord's sacrifice, that is, the Eucharist.

"My beloved brothers and sons...You must apply your energies to the duty of teaching in the name of Christ....Share with all mankind the Word of God you received with joy. And for this reason, read and meditate on the Word of the Lord. Believe what you read, teach what you believe and put into practice what you teach. You should never deliver a homily without much prayer, with the Bible in hand. Do not forget this. Let the doctrine you teach be true nourishment for the People of God: when it comes from the heart and arises from prayer, it will be fruitful.

"...Know what you are doing and imitate the mystery you celebrate. In memory of the Lord's death and Resurrection, carry Christ's death within you and walk with Him in newness of Life...You will celebrate the liturgy and offer thanks and praise to God throughout the day, praying not only for the People of God, but for the whole of humanity....These are the affinities proper to priests: close to God in prayer, close to the bishop who is your father, close to the presbytery, to others priests, as brothers without excoriating each other (speaking ill of each other), and close to the People of God."

His words should help us all understand the Gift of Priesthood among us and the call for each of us to mold our hearts after the Good Shepherd.

May the Lord bless and keep you close to Him, Monsignor

Are you 70 1/2 or older and looking for a tax break? Did you loose your contribution deduction? Do you make withdraws from your IRA? "IRA owners age 70 1/2 or older can transfer up to \$100,000 per year to an eligible charity tax-free. The transfer can count as their required minimum distribution for the year. Funds must be transferred directly by the IRA trustee to the eligible charity. For details, see Publication 590-B." As sited from the IRS website. You should consult your own tax, legal or financial advisors before engaging in any transaction.

# **DESDE EL PASTOR**

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

A mediados de mayo en el Vaticano, el Papa Francisco ordenó diecinueve sacerdotes nuevos para la Iglesia Universal. Su homilía y sus reflexiones personales durante la misa ofrecen una visión profunda del don de las Ordenes Sagradas para la iglesia de hoy. Permíteme compartir algunos de ellos.

"Nuestros hijos han sido llamados a la orden de los sacerdotes. Nos hará bien a todos considerar detenidamente la posición a la que deben ser promovidos en la Iglesia ... Jesucristo eligió a algunos de sus seguidores para llevar a cabo públicamente en la Iglesia un ministerio sacerdotal en su nombre en nombre de la humanidad, continuando su Misión personal como maestro, como sacerdote, como pastor.

"De hecho, por esta razón fue enviado por el Padre, y él a su vez envió al mundo a los Apóstoles, y luego a los Obispos y sus sucesores. Los sacerdotes son colaboradores de la orden de los Obispos, a quienes se unen en el oficio sacerdotal y están llamados a servir al Pueblo de Dios ... Están llamados a ser moldeados a la semejanza de Cristo, el Sacerdote Supremo y Eterno ... compartiendo en el sacerdocio de su obispo, predicar el Evangelio, sostener al pueblo de Dios y presidir los ritos de adoración, sobre todo la celebración del sacrificio del Señor, es decir, la Eucaristía.

"Mis amados hermanos e hijos ... Deben aplicar sus energías al deber de enseñar en el nombre de Cristo ... Comparta con toda la humanidad la Palabra de Dios que recibió con alegría. Y por esta razón, lee y medita en la Palabra del Señor. Cree lo que lees, enseña lo que crees y pon en práctica lo que enseñas. Nunca debes entregar una homilía sin mucha oración, con la Biblia en la mano. No te olvides de esto. Deje que la doctrina que usted enseña sea un alimento para el Pueblo de Dios: cuando viene del corazón y surge de la oración, será fructífera.

"... Sepa lo que está haciendo e imite el misterio que celebra. En memoria de la muerte y resurrección del Señor, lleve la muerte de Cristo dentro de usted y camine con Él en la novedad de la vida ... Celebrará la liturgia y ofrecerá gracias y alabanzas a Dios a lo largo del día, orando no solo por el Pueblo de Dios, sino por toda la humanidad ... Estas son las afinidades propias de los sacerdotes: cerca de Dios en oración, cerca del obispo que es tu padre, cerca del presbiterio, de otros sacerdotes, como hermanos sin excoriarse (hablar mal el uno del otro) ), y cerca del Pueblo de Dios ".

Sus palabras deben ayudarnos a todos a comprender el don del sacerdocio entre nosotros y el llamado a cada uno de nosotros a moldear nuestros corazones según el Buen Pastor.
