Dear Brothers and Sister in the Lord:

In a recent reflection given to the Faithful who were gathered in St. Peter's Square in Rome to recite the Angelus with Pope Francis, he addressed the need for overcoming barriers and creating bridges between all peoples. His words merit sharing them with each of us:

"After washing the feet of the twelve Apostles, Jesus says to them: 'A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, so you also should love one another' (Jn.13:34)....In what sense does Jesus call this commandment 'new'? Because we know that already in the Old Testament, God had ordered members of His people to love their neighbor as themselves (cf. Lev. 19:18). To those who asked Him which was the greatest commandment of the Law, Jesus would reply that the first was to love God with all your heart and the second, to love your neighbor as yourself (cf. Mt.22L38-39).

"What then is the novelty of this commandment that Jesus entrusts to His disciples?...The novelty lies wholly in Jesus Christ's love with which He gave His life for us. It is God's universal love, without any conditions or limits, which reaches its culmination on the cross... Jesus loved us first. He loved us despite our frailties, our limitations and our human weaknesses. He asks us to love one another, not so much with our love, but with His love, which the Holy Spirit instills in our hearts, if we

invoke Him with faith. In this way—and only in this way—can we love one another not only as we love ourselves but as He loved us.

"...I will ask you a question; each of you can respond in your heart. Am I capable of loving my enemies...those people who have offended me? Am I capable of forgiving them? Jesus' love shows us the other as a present or future member of the community of Jesus' friends. It spurs us to dialogue and helps us listen to one another and to mutually get to know each other. Love opens up toward the others, becoming the foundation of human relationships. It renders us capable of overcoming the barriers of our own weaknesses and prejudices. Jesus' love within us creates bridges, teaches new paths, triggers the dynamism of fraternity. With her maternal intercession, may the Virgin Mary help us to receive from her Son Jesus the gift of His commandment, and from the Holy Spirit the strength to put it into practice in everyday life."

May God's gifts of mercy and love enable us to hear this lesson of Pope Francis. May His Grace enable us to honestly examine our hearts and seek forgiveness where it is necessary, as well as grant it to those for whom and from whom we hope to create a Family of Faith, Hope and Love.

# **DESDE EL PASTOR**

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

En una reciente reflexión dada a los fieles que se reunieron en la Plaza de San Pedro en Roma para recitar el Ángelus con el Papa Francisco, abordó la necesidad de superar barreras y crear puentes entre todos los pueblos. Sus palabras merecen compartirlas con cada uno de nosotros:

"Después de lavar los pies de los doce apóstoles, Jesús les dice: 'Un mandamiento nuevo os doy, que os améis unos a otros; así como yo te he amado, también debes amarte el uno al otro "(Jn.13: 34) ... ¿En qué sentido llama Jesús este mandamiento" nuevo "? Porque sabemos que ya en el Antiguo Testamento, Dios había ordenado a los miembros de Su pueblo que amaran a su prójimo como a sí mismos (cf. Lev. 19:18). A aquellos que le preguntaron cuál era el mayor mandamiento de la ley, Jesús respondería que el primero era amar a Dios con todo tu corazón y el segundo, amar a tu prójimo como a ti mismo (cf. Mt.22L38-39).

"¿Cuál es entonces la novedad de este mandamiento que Jesús confía a sus discípulos? ... La novedad reside totalmente en el amor de Jesucristo con el que dio su vida por nosotros. Es el amor universal de Dios, sin condiciones ni límites, el que alcanza su culminación en la cruz ... Jesús nos amó primero. Nos amó a pesar de nuestras debilidades, nuestras limitaciones y nuestras debilidades humanas. Nos pide que nos amemos unos a otros, no tanto con nuestro amor, sino con su amor, que el Espíritu Santo inculca en nuestros corazones, si lo invocamos con fe. De esta manera, y solo de esta manera, podemos amarnos unos a otros, no solo como nos amamos a nosotros mismos, sino también a nosotros.

"... Te haré una pregunta; Cada uno de ustedes puede responder en su corazón. ¿Soy capaz de amar a mis enemigos ... esas personas que me han ofendido? ¿Soy capaz de perdonarlos? El amor de Jesús nos muestra al otro como un miembro presente o futuro de la comunidad de amigos de Jesús. Nos estimula a dialogar y nos ayuda a escucharnos y conocernos mutuamente. El amor se abre hacia los demás, convirtiéndose en el fundamento de las relaciones humanas. Nos hace capaces de superar las barreras de nuestras propias debilidades y prejuicios. El amor de Jesús dentro de nosotros crea puentes, enseña nuevos caminos, desencadena el dinamismo de la fraternidad. Con su intercesión materna, que la Virgen María nos ayude a recibir de su Hijo Jesús el don de Su mandamiento, y del Espíritu Santo la fuerza para ponerlo en práctica en la vida cotidiana ".

Que los dones de Dios de misericordia y amor nos permitan escuchar esta lección del Papa Francisco. Que Su Gracia nos permita examinar honestamente nuestros corazones y buscar el perdón donde sea necesario, así como otorgarlo a aquellos para quienes esperamos crear una Familia de Fe, Esperanza y Amor.
