Dear Brothers and Sister in the Lord:

It's time for an update on our renovations at both campuses. We have run into slight delays for each project.

At Saint Mary, our reconstruction team has had to delay work for us due to an accident for one of their main workers. The accident did not occur while at work for us, so no one needs to be concerned about any legal ramifications; however, due to there being some physical injury, the healing process is delaying any work. Let us all pray that time heals quickly so that work can resume as soon as possible. We are still in need of consultation with the Bishop's Office for approval to move forward with the reconstruction/renovation work that is needed on the bell tower. That will also require additional financing since the proposed costs is over Three Hundred Thousand dollars! As we clarify the issues involved, I will update you all in future bulletins.

At Saint Ambrose, the delay is the result of both the weather—I wonder when there will be a week without storms!—and the worker schedules for the Fredericks Company. Since the church roof is the one that serves us all, I have decided to have it repaired/replaced first. Although the rectory seems to spring new leaks with each passing weather system (even the bedrooms for Fr. Shine

and me now have drips!) I do believe that the House of the Lord must be addressed first. I am reminded of the oracle of the prophet Nathan to King David. Whereas I am not a member of any royal family, I don't think the house in which I live should be fixed before the one that houses the Presence of Our Lord. Hopefully Mother Nature will begin to cooperate and provide a few weeks of fair weather in which to accomplish the necessary repairs.

In both situations we need to remind ourselves that none of this work can be accomplished without our willingness to provide the financial resources. At St. Ambrose we have only \$19,144 towards our matching goal for \$80,000. At St. Mary we are still in need of \$151,679 in order to meet the First Phase costs. In addition to those, with approval of the Bishop's Office we will be facing Phase Two with about an equal overall cost (\$330,000). I recognize that the figures are staggering, however, if we wish to maintain the buildings that have stood from generations past for the benefit of generations to come, we must be willing to commit ourselves to that goal. May God bless each of us as we discern how to help.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Es hora de una actualización de nuestras renovaciones en ambos campus. Nos hemos topado con retrasos leves para cada proyecto.

En Saint Mary, nuestro equipo de reconstrucción ha tenido que retrasar el trabajo para nosotros debido a un accidente para uno de sus trabajadores principales. El accidente no ocurrió mientras trabajábamos para nosotros, por lo que nadie debe preocuparse por las ramificaciones legales; sin embargo, debido a que hay alguna lesión física, el proceso de curación está retrasando cualquier trabajo. Oremos todos para que el tiempo se cure rápidamente para que el trabajo pueda reanudarse lo antes posible. Todavía necesitamos una consulta con la Oficina del Obispo para su aprobación para seguir adelante con el trabajo de reconstrucción / renovación que se necesita en el campanario. ¡Eso también requerirá financiamiento adicional ya que los costos propuestos superan los trescientos mil dólares! A medida que aclaremos los problemas involucrados, los actualizaré a todos en futuros boletines.

En Saint Ambrose, la demora es el resultado del clima, ¿me pregunto cuándo habrá una semana sin tormentas!, Y los horarios de los trabajadores de la Compañía Fredericks. Ya que el techo de la iglesia es el que nos sirve a todos, he decidido repararlo / reemplazarlo primero. Aunque la rectoría parece tener nuevas fugas con cada sistema meteorológico pasajero (¡incluso las habitaciones para el Padre Shine y para mí ahora gotean!) Creo que la Casa del Señor debe ser dirigida primero. Me recuerda el oráculo del profeta Natán al rey David. Si bien no soy miembro de ninguna familia real, no creo que la casa en la que vivo deba repararse ante la que alberga la Presencia de Nuestro Señor. Con suerte, la Madre Naturaleza comenzará a cooperar y brindará algunas semanas de buen tiempo para llevar a cabo las reparaciones necesarias.

En ambas situaciones, debemos recordarnos que nada de este trabajo puede lograrse sin nuestra voluntad de proporcionar los recursos financieros. En St. Ambrose tenemos solo \$19,144 para alcanzar nuestra meta de \$80,000. En St. Mary todavía necesitamos \$151,679 para cubrir los costos de la Primera Fase. Además de eso, con la aprobación de la Oficina del Obispo, enfrentaremos la Fase Dos con un costo general equivalente (\$330,000). Reconozco que las cifras son asombrosas, sin embargo, si deseamos mantener los edificios que se han mantenido de generaciones pasadas en beneficio de las generaciones venideras, debemos estar dispuestos a comprometernos con ese objetivo. Que Dios nos bendiga a cada uno de nosotros al discernir cómo ayudar.
