One of my dearest friends, whom I have known since 1975, sent me the following e-mail this past week. I believe it is full of wisdom and counsel so I'd like to share it with you.

"If you can start the day without caffeine; If you can get going without pep pills; If you can resist complaining and boring people with your troubles; If you can eat the same food every day and be grateful for it; If you can understand when your loved ones are too busy to give you any time; If you can overlook it when something goes wrong through no fault of yours and those you love take it out on you; If you can take criticism and blame without resentment; If you can ignore a friend's limited education and never correct him; If you can resist treating a rich friend better than a poor friend; If you can face the world without lies and deceit; If you can conquer tension without medical help; If you can relax without liquor; If you can sleep without aid of drugs; If you can say honestly that deep in your heart you have no prejudice against creed, color, religion, or politics; Then, my friends, you are almost as good as your dog. May God bless you, Msgr. Art Valezano"

I have never met Msgr. Valezano but I would certainly like the opportunity to shake his hand and thank him for the lessons that he has voiced in these words. Far too often in our pilgrimage towards the Kingdom, we for

get the importance of graciousness and the value of a welcoming heart. The concept of modern society seems to be "ME first and the hell with the rest!" What a shame. With an attitude like that, is it any wonder that we have created a world in which the powerfully self-created bullies are the apparent "chosen ones" and those who seek to challenge our perceptions of self-righteousness and shunned and ignored.

I don't believe in getting even with others and I pray daily for the compassion and conviction that guided the Apostles to learn how to accept the teachings and actions of Jesus Christ. I am convinced that the more willing we are to pray for the humility that marked the lives of saint gone before us, the greater room we create within us to become a shelter of acceptance and loving kindness towards others. It is not a case of simply lying down like a doormat and allowing others to walk all over us. It is an inner strength of saying God placed me where I am, the way I am, to do the best I am able to transform the little part of the world that I share into a better place than what it was before me. May He bless each of our efforts to do the same.

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Uno de mis amigos más queridos, a quien conozco desde 1975, me envió el siguiente correo electrónico la semana pasada. Creo que está lleno de sabiduría y consejo, así que me gustaría compartirlo con ustedes.

"Si puedes empezar el día sin cafeína; Si puedes seguir adelante sin pildoras; Si puedes resistirte a quejarte y aburrir a la gente con tus problemas; Si puedes comer la misma comida todos los días y estar agradecido por ello; Si puede entender cuándo sus seres queridos están demasiado ocupados para darle tiempo y tiempo; Si puede pasarlo por alto cuando algo sale mal y no es culpa suya, los que ama lo sacan de usted; Si puedes aceptar la crítica y la culpa sin resentimiento; Si puedes ignorar la educación limitada de un amigo y nunca corregirlo; Si puedes resistirte a tratar a un amigo rico mejor que a un amigo pobre; Si puedes enfrentarte al mundo sin mentiras ni engaños; Si puedes vencer la tensión sin ayuda médica; Si puedes relajarte sin licor; Si puedes dormir sin ayuda de drogas; Si puedes decir honestamente que en lo más profundo de tu corazón no tienes ningún prejuicio contra el credo, el color, la religión o la política; Entonces, mis amigos, son casi tan buenos como su perro. Que Dios te bendiga, Mons. Arte Valezano "

Nunca he conocido a Msgr. Valezano, pero ciertamente me gustaría tener la oportunidad de darle la mano y agradecerle las lecciones que ha expresado con estas palabras. Con demasiada frecuencia en nuestro peregrinaje hacia el Reino, olvidamos la importancia de la gracia y el valor de un corazón acogedor. El concepto de la sociedad moderna parece ser "¡YO primero y al infierno con el resto!". Qué vergüenza. Con una actitud como esa, no es de extrañar que hayamos creado un mundo en el que los matones poderosamente autocreados son los "elegidos" aparentes y aquellos que buscan desafiar nuestras percepciones de la justicia propia y rechazados e ignorados.

No creo en reconciliarme con los demás y rezo diariamente por la compasión y la convicción que guió a los Apóstoles a aprender cómo aceptar las enseñanzas y acciones de Jesucristo. Cada uno de nosotros ha sabido cómo se siente el rechazo; ¡cada uno de nosotros ha sabido cuán dañinas pueden ser las palabras y cómo las acciones dañinas crean cicatrices que pueden tardar toda una vida en sanar! Estoy convencido de que cuanto más deseemos estar en oración por la humildad que marcó las vidas de los santos que se han ido antes que nosotros, más espacio creamos dentro de nosotros para convertirnos en un refugio de aceptación y amorosa bondad hacia los demás. No se trata simplemente de acostarse como un felpudo y permitir que otros caminen sobre nosotros. Es una fuerza interna de decir que Dios me colocó donde estoy, como soy, para hacer lo mejor que pueda para transformar la pequeña parte del mundo que comparto en un lugar mejor que lo que era antes de mí. Que El bendiga cada uno de nuestros esfuerzos para hacer lo mismo.

All government officials (federal, state, local levels, executive, legislative, judicial branches), attorneys, paralegals, law students and their spouses are cordially invited to attend. One does not have to be Catholic to join us in prayer and fellowship for the legal community. The Red Mass is a tradition in the Catholic Church which dates back to the 13th century. A Red Mass was initially celebrated to mark the beginning of the annual term of the courts but can be held at other times. It has always been the teaching of the Church to respect proper governmental authority and to seek divine guidance and protection for those who represent others. Moreover, those who serve in the legal community have a pivotal role promoting unity, liberty, justice, equal protection under the law and the common good.
