Dear Brothers and Sister in the Lord:

Once again it is time to give an update on the progress of projects between Saint Ambrose and Saint Mary churches. As many of you are aware, I do not like speaking about money but I realize that without addressing this basic fact, things cannot be accomplished.

The progress at Saint Mary is delayed for two reasons. The primary one is that our principal foreman was involved in an accident that has hindered his ability to climb ladders. Once he is freed from doctor's care and allowed to return to full time work, the inside refurbishing of the church walls will continue. In the meanwhile, I am in the process of seeking permission from the bishop to complete the outside restoration of the Bell Tower. As you know from previous bulletin announcements, the Second Phase of Restoration (the Tower) will also cost nearly 330K to complete. It is a necessary part of maintaining the historic treasure that Saint Mary church has become. I would ask every parishioner at Saint Mary to consider making another major contribution to this second phase so that the building may be fully restored to a worthwhile, historic condition.

At Saint Ambrose the replacement of the roof of the church is well underway. We have had at least five days delay due to weather (over which none of us has any control). The weather for the next two weeks, after this coming Wednesday, only calls for one day of rain so we

may get lucky in that regard. Once the church roof is finalized, the rectory and garage will also undergo roof replacement. We are nearly two-thirds of the way towards our goal of 75K for a matching fund campaign for the roofs. Hopefully the remaining 25K will be given through the support of everyone so that the roofs can be completely paid for upon completion. It looks like the project will be finished by mid-September allowing for good weather!

I do sincerely wish to thank ALL parishioners who have contributed to these projects in both treasure and prayer. The fact that we have been able to accomplish them during the harsh economic times that we face as a city and a church are indeed a sign of Trust in the Lord and a willingness to strive to be Good Stewards of the gifts God has given each of us. I firmly believe that we have chosen to accept the call of Bishop Doherty and are Uniting in Heart with one another to bring to fruition the vision he has placed before us. A common commitment to the preservation of the buildings entrusted to our care shows a willingness to prepare for the future so that the generations to come after us may be as grateful to God for the Community of Faith that we have and strive to bring forth His Kingdom in our midst. THANK YOU for your willingness to join in this worthwhile effort.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Una vez más, es hora de dar una actualización sobre el progreso de los proyectos entre las iglesias de San Ambrosio y Santa María. Como muchos de ustedes saben, no me gusta hablar de dinero, pero me doy cuenta de que sin abordar este hecho básico, las cosas no se pueden lograr.

El progreso en Saint Mary se retrasa por dos razones. La principal es que nuestro capataz principal estuvo involucrado en un accidente que ha obstaculizado su capacidad para subir escaleras. Una vez que sea liberado de la atención médica y se le permita volver a trabajar a tiempo completo, la restauración interior de las paredes de la iglesia continuará. Mientras tanto, estoy en el proceso de pedir permiso al obispo para completar la restauración exterior del Campanario. Como saben por anuncios de boletines anteriores, la Segunda Fase de Restauración (la Torre) también costará cerca de 330K en completarse. Es una parte necesaria para mantener el tesoro histórico en el que se ha convertido la iglesia de Santa María. Le pediría a todos los feligreses de Saint Mary que consideren hacer otra contribución importante a esta segunda fase para que el edificio pueda restaurarse completamente a una condición histórica que valga la pena.

En San Ambrosio, el reemplazo del techo de la iglesia está en marcha. Hemos tenido al menos cinco días de retraso debido al clima (sobre el cual ninguno de nosotros tiene ningún control). El clima para las próximas dos semanas, después de este próximo miércoles, solo requiere un día de lluvia para que podamos tener suerte en ese sentido. Una vez que se finalice el techo de la iglesia, la rectoría y el garaje también serán reemplazados. Estamos a casi dos tercios del camino hacia nuestro objetivo de 75K para una campaña de fondos de contrapartida para los techos. Con suerte, los 25K restantes se darán a través del apoyo de todos para que los techos se puedan pagar por completo al finalizar. ¡Parece que el proyecto estará terminado a mediados de septiembre, lo que permitirá un buen clima!

Deseo sinceramente agradecer a TODOS los feligreses que han contribuido a estos proyectos tanto en tesoros como en oración. El hecho de que hayamos podido cumplirlos durante los duros tiempos económicos que enfrentamos como ciudad y como iglesia son, de hecho, una señal de Confianza en el Señor y una voluntad de esforzarse por ser Buenos Administradores de los dones que Dios le ha dado a cada uno de ellos. nosotros. Creo firmemente que hemos elegido aceptar el llamado del obispo Doherty y nos estamos uniendo en corazón para hacer realidad la visión que nos ha presentado. Un compromiso común con la preservación de los edificios confiados a nuestro cuidado muestra una disposición a prepararse para el futuro para que las generaciones venideras puedan estar tan agradecidas a Dios por la Comunidad de Fe que tenemos y nos esforzamos por traer a Su Reino. en medio de nosotros. GRACIAS por su disposición a unirse a este valioso esfuerzo.


