As you all know, last week I journeyed to Ohio for the burial of my sister-in-law, Peggy. My twin brother wanted to wait until the ground around their grave had dried out enough for the foundation to be laid for their headstone. It is the bench variety that has their names and dates engraved on it. Their marker sits directly behind our parents' marker, which stands beside my younger sister, Margaret's grave and her second born babe, Gabriel. The day was a perfect fall occurrence, the sky was clear blue except for two cirrus clouds that stretched over the area where the graves are.

As we all started gathering around the gravesite for the service, my older sister, Tina, sat down on the marker bench to await the arrival of some of Peggy's side of our extended family. Tina looked up at the sky and called out to all of us to look above. As we did, we saw

stretched between the two small clouds the arc of a rainbow! This was in a perfectly clear, blue sky! I couldn't help but comment of the Arc of God's rainbow for Noah and how it was a certain sign of His Presence among us as well as the assurance that Peggy was shining brightly among those who have gone before us. It was truly a treasured gift. Fortunately, my brother's son, David, had the sense of mind to take a picture of the rainbow on his cell phone so that it has been preserved for all to see.

It is wonderful how God manifests His Love to us in ways that we never expect but are always comforted. The fact that we were able to come together from three different States and parts of our country and share a moment of surrender to the Lord of Life served to renew for each of us the certain assurance that Our God is a Loving God Who blesses us abundantly.

So, try to enjoy the simple gifts of life. Enjoy the embrace of friendship, the wonder of loving kindness, the comfort of the presence of those who are given to you in whatever moment of life you find. All are ways in which the Father bestows the bounty of His Life and Love. Blessed be the Lord, now and forever.

El día fue una caída perfecta, el cielo estaba azul claro excepto por dos cirros que se extendían sobre el área donde están las tumbas.

Cuando todos comenzamos a reunirnos alrededor de la tumba para el servicio, mi hermana mayor, Tina, se sentó en el banco de espera para esperar la llegada de parte del lado de Peggy de nuestra extensa familia. Tina miró hacia el cielo y nos llamó a todos para mirar hacia arriba. ¡Mientras lo hacíamos, vimos estirado entre las dos pequeñas nubes el arco iris! ¡Esto estaba en un cielo azul perfectamente claro! No pude evitar comentar el arco iris del Arco de Dios para Noé y cómo era una cierta señal de Su Presencia entre nosotros, así como la seguridad de que Peggy estaba brillando entre los que nos precedieron. Fue realmente un regalo preciado. Afortunadamente, el hijo de mi hermano, David, tuvo la sensatez de tomar una foto del arcoíris en su teléfono celular para que se haya conservado para que todos lo vean.

Es maravilloso cómo Dios nos manifiesta su amor de maneras que nunca esperamos pero siempre nos consuela. El hecho de que pudimos unirnos desde tres Estados y partes diferentes de nuestro país y compartir un momento de rendición al Señor de la Vida sirvió para renovar para cada uno de nosotros la certeza de que Nuestro Dios es un Dios Amoroso que nos bendice abundantemente .

Por lo tanto, trate de disfrutar los simples regalos de la vida. Disfrute del abrazo de la amistad, la maravilla de la bondad amorosa, la comodidad de la presencia de quienes se le brindan en cualquier momento de la vida que encuentre. Todas son formas en que el Padre otorga la generosidad de su vida y amor. Bendito sea el Señor, ahora y para siempre.
