

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

On October Thirteenth of this year, in Rome, Pope Francis celebrated Mass at the Vatican to preside over the canonization of five “Blesseds” of the Church. Among them was Cardinal John Henry Newman (1801-1890), the first Briton saint in forty years. In commenting upon this event, the Prince of Wales offered the following observations:

“In the age when he lived, Newman stood for the life of the spirit against the forces that would debase human dignity and human destiny. In the age in which he attains sainthood, his example is needed more than ever—for the manner in which, at his best, he could advocate without accusation, could disagree without disrespect and, perhaps most of all could see differences as places of encounter rather than exclusion.

“At a time when faith was being questioned as never before, Newman, one of the greatest theologians of the nineteenth century, applied his intellect to one of the most pressing questions of our era: What should be the relationship of faith to a skeptical, secular age?...Whatever our beliefs, and no matter what our own tradition may be, we can only be grateful to Newman for the gifts, rooted in his Catholic faith, which he shared with wider society....Harmony requires difference. The concept rests at the very heart of

Christian theology in the concept of the Trinity. As such, difference is not to be feared.

“...As an Anglican, he guided the church back to its Catholic roots, and as a Catholic he was ready to learn from the Anglican tradition, such as his promoting the role of the laity. He gave the Catholic Church renewed confidence as it re-established itself in a land in which it had once been uprooted.

“...As we mark the life of this great Briton, this great churchman and, as we can now say, this great saint, who bridges the divisions between traditions, it is surely right that we give thanks for the friendship which, despite the parting, has not merely endured, but has strengthened. In the image of divine harmony which Newman expressed so eloquently, we can see how, ultimately, as we follow with sincerity and courage the different paths to which conscience calls us, all our divisions can lead to a greater understanding and all our ways can find a common home.”

May God grant each of us the openness of mind and heart that was so wondrously displayed in the life of the newly proclaimed Saint John Newman, so that we may continue to seek ways in which to be United in Heart with one another on our pilgrimage to the House of the Lord.

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en el Señor:

El 13 de octubre de este año, en Roma, el Papa Francisco celebró la misa en el Vaticano para presidir la canonización de los cinco "beatos" de la Iglesia. Entre ellos estaba el cardenal John Henry Newman (1801-1890), el primer santo británico en cuarenta años. Al comentar sobre este evento, el Príncipe de Gales ofreció las siguientes observaciones:

"En la época en que vivió, Newman defendió la vida del espíritu contra las fuerzas que degradarían la dignidad humana y el destino humano. En la época en que alcanza la santidad, su ejemplo es más necesario que nunca: por la forma en que, en el mejor de los casos, podría abogar sin acusación, podría estar en desacuerdo sin faltarle el respeto y, tal vez, sobre todo, podría ver las diferencias como lugares de encuentro en lugar de exclusión.

"En un momento en que se cuestionaba la fe como nunca antes, Newman, uno de los más grandes teólogos del siglo XIX, aplicó su intelecto a una de las preguntas más apremiantes de nuestra era: cuál debería ser la relación de fe con un escéptico, ¿edad secular? ... Sean cuales sean nuestras creencias, y no importa cuál sea nuestra propia tradición, solo podemos estar agradecidos con Newman por los dones, arraigados en su fe católica, que compartió con la sociedad en general ... La armonía requiere diferencia. El concepto descansa en el corazón de la teología cristiana en el concepto de la Trinidad. Como tal, no hay que temer la diferencia.

"... Como anglicano, guió a la iglesia a sus raíces católicas, y como católico estaba listo para aprender de la tradición anglicana, como su promoción del papel de los laicos. Le dio a la Iglesia Católica una confianza renovada al restablecerse en una tierra en la que una vez fue desarraigada.

"... Mientras marcamos la vida de este gran británico, este gran hombre de iglesia y, como podemos decir ahora, este gran santo, que salva las divisiones entre las tradiciones, seguramente es correcto que agradezcamos la amistad que, a pesar de la separación, no solo ha soportado, sino que se ha fortalecido. En la imagen de armonía divina que Newman expresó tan elocuentemente, podemos ver cómo, en última instancia, a medida que seguimos con sinceridad y coraje los diferentes caminos a los que la conciencia nos llama, todas nuestras divisiones pueden conducir a una mayor comprensión y todos nuestros caminos pueden encontrar un hogar común".

Que Dios nos conceda a cada uno de nosotros la apertura de la mente y el corazón que se mostró tan maravillosamente en la vida del recién proclamado San Juan Newman, para que podamos continuar buscando formas de unirnos en el corazón en nuestra peregrinación para La casa del Señor.
