Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

I received two emails this past week from friends and relations regarding the loss of loved ones. I'd like to share them both. The first is entitled "I'm Free"

"Don't grieve for me, for now I'm free, I'm following the path God has laid for me. I took His hand when I heard His call, I turned my back and left it all. I could not stay another day, to laugh, to love, to work or play. Tasks left undone must stay that way, I found the peace at the close of the day.

The second came in the form of a Thank-You note: "Perhaps you sent a lovely card, or sat quietly in a chair. Perhaps you sent a floral spray; if so, we saw it there. Perhaps you spoke the kindest words, as any friend could say. Perhaps you were not there at all, just thought of us that day. Whatever you did to console the heart, we thank you so much, whatever the part."

Both of these can help ease the pain of loss that death can create within us and both of them bring an assurance of enduring loving kindness that friendship and compassion creates in every heart that has learned the meaning of Love and Life. It is my hope that either of them or both together may touch your sense of loss and fill whatever void death has brought you with the knowledge that God provides for us in whatever circumstance we find ourselves and brings to us the necessary grace to endure whatever challenge of life there is.

May Our Lord continue to bless each of us with the certainty of His Loving Kindness and the comfort of caring friends who seem to know exactly the right thing to say at the right moment.

Sacrament of First Reconciliation and Communion—Primera Reconciliación y Comunión

The retreat for First Reconciliation will be held on November 10 from 8:30 AM to 11:30 PM at St. Mary in the cafeteria. Attendance of both parents and the child is required. Please make necessary arrangements for child care if you have other young children.

Reconciliation will take place on December 4, 2019. The children will celebrate the sacrament either at the 1:00 PM service or the 6:00 PM service at St. Mary.

For First Communion if your child was NOT BAPTISED at St. Mary or St. Ambrose a RECENT ISSUED Baptism certificate is required. The retreat for First Communion will be held on April 19, 2020, the time and place is to be determined.
