Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

One of the best books in my personal library is a gift from Bishop Doherty that was given to all priests of the diocese. It is entitled "A Life of Daring Simplicity" (Daily Meditations on the Priesthood), edited by Fr. Michael A. Becker. The title is taken from the autobiography of Saint Pope John Twenty-third (one of my personal favorite saints).

Within the work, the meditation given for December eleventh is titled "Our Prayer for God's People." It is an excerpt from the writing of Gerard McGinnity, "Christmen: Experience of Priesthood Today." Allow me to quote a few passages from it:

"A Priest's sense of ministry needs nourishment and we ought never grow apart or aloof from the people we serve. Even the continual respect people show a priest renews his awareness of the 'treasure we hold in common clay pots,' for they salute the office as much as the man.

"The trusting way in which people ask for our intercessory prayer, as well as invigorating our own weakness, reminds us of that commitment made at ordination to 'maintain and deepen a spirit of prayer appropriate to our way of life, and in keeping with what is required of us, to celebrate faithfully the Liturgy of the Hours for the Church and for the world.'

"People keep reminding us that we are appointed priests on their behalf and that we have the responsibility of bringing their needs with us to prayer. When we pray the Prayer of the Church for the world, we are exercising the mediatorship of the priesthood. The high priest Aaron, in case he might forget his continued duty to pray on behalf of his people, always brought the sign of the people on his breast when he went into the Holy of Holies to pray. A priest... intercedes for the people but he also shows genuine care and compassion for their needs. He celebrates the sacred mysteries but tries in his life to epitomize the Word he preaches and the Sacrifice he makes present....He develops spiritually 'through his liturgical ministry only if he stands judged in his own life by the Word he proclaims to others and challenged to the same conversion, faith and love that he preaches to his people."

As one of the daily meditations contained in this book, this one in particular reminds every priest that his gift of ministry is not his own. It is given to him to be given to those whom he has been called to serve. Please pray that Fr. Mark and I may emulate these words as best we can by the grace of God. May our Blessed Lord keep each of you close to His Heart.

# **DESDE EL PASTOR**

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en el Señor:

Uno de los mejores libros de mi biblioteca personal es un obsequio del obispo Doherty que se entregó a todos los sacerdotes de la diócesis. Se titula "A Life of Daring Simplicity" (Meditaciones diarias sobre el sacerdocio), editado por el p. Michael A. Becker. El título está tomado de la autobiografía de San Papa Juan Vigésimo tercero (uno de mis santos favoritos personales).

Dentro del trabajo, la meditación dada para el 11 de diciembre se titula "Nuestra oración por el pueblo de Dios". Es un extracto de la escritura de Gerard McGinnity, "Christmen: Experience of Priesthood Today". Me permitirá para citar algunos pasajes de él:

"El sentido de ministerio de un sacerdote necesita alimento y nunca debemos separarnos o alejarnos de las personas a las que servimos. Incluso el respeto continuo que las personas muestran a un sacerdote renueva su conciencia del "tesoro que tenemos en ollas de barro comunes", ya que saludan la oficina tanto como el hombre.

"La forma confiada en que las personas piden nuestra oración intercesora, así como vigorizar nuestra propia debilidad, nos recuerda ese compromiso hecho en la ordenación para 'mantener y profundizar un espíritu de oración apropiado para nuestra forma de vida, y de acuerdo con lo que se requiere de nosotros, celebrar fielmente la Liturgia de las Horas para la Iglesia y para el mundo.'

"La gente sigue recordándonos que somos nombrados sacerdotes en su nombre y que tenemos la responsabilidad de llevar sus necesidades con nosotros a la oración. Cuando rezamos la Oración de la Iglesia por el mundo, estamos ejerciendo la mediación del sacerdocio. El sumo sacerdote Aaron, en caso de que pudiera olvidar su deber continuo de rezar en nombre de su pueblo, siempre traía el signo de las personas en su pecho cuando entraba en el Lugar Santísimo de Santo para rezar. Un sacerdote ... intercede por las personas, pero también muestra un cuidado genuino y compasión por sus necesidades. Celebra los misterios sagrados pero trata en su vida de personificar la Palabra que predica y el Sacrificio que hace presente ... Se desarrolla espiritualmente a través de su ministerio litúrgico solo si es juzgado en su propia vida por la Palabra que proclama a otros y desafiado. a la misma conversión, fe y amor que predica a su pueblo."

Como una de las meditaciones diarias contenidas en este libro, esta en particular recuerda a cada sacerdote que su don de ministerio no es suyo. Se le da a él a aquellos a quienes ha sido llamado a servir. Por favor, oren para que el p. Mark y yo podemos emular estas palabras lo mejor que podamos por la gracia de Dios. Que nuestro Bendito Señor los mantenga a cada uno cerca de Su Corazón.

- Mailed donations **must be postmarked no later than December 31st**. NOTE: If it is dropped in a mail collection box on the last day of the year, it may not get postmarked until the first business day of the following year.
- If a donor drops donations off at a school or at IQE's office, be sure that staff is available to accept the donation.
- Stock/Mutual Fund Gifts transfers **should be initiated by December 20th** with transferring broker to ensure completion before year-end.
