

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

In the Gospel of Saint Matthew Jesus teaches: "You have heard that it was said 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you..." (Mt.5:43-44) Pope Francis recently spoke on this teaching of Christ. Here is part of what he said:

"We might think that Jesus' teaching is part of a plan: in the end, the wicked will desist. But that is not why Jesus asks us to love those who do us harm. What, then, is the reason? It is that the Father, our Father, continues to love everyone, even when His love is not reciprocated. ....Jesus did not point a finger at those who wrongfully condemned Him and put Him to a cruel death, but opened His arms to them on the cross. And He forgave those who drove nails into His wrists (Lk.23:33-34)

"If we want to be disciples of Christ, if we want to call ourselves Christians, this is the only way; there is no other. Having been loved by God, we are called to love in return; having been forgiven, we are called to forgive; having been touched by love, we are called to love without waiting for others to love first; having been saved graciously, we are called to seek no benefit from the good we do.

"...Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you. This is the Christian innovation. It is the Christian difference. Pray and love: this is what we must

do...The love of Jesus knows no boundaries or barriers. The Lord demands of us the courage to have a love that does not count the cost; because the measure of Jesus is love without measure....Where the command of universal love is concerned, let us not accept excuses or preach prudent caution. The Lord was not cautious; He did not yield to compromises. He asks of us the extremism of charity. This is the only legitimate kind of Christian extremism: the extremism of love.

...If the goal were impossible, the Lord would not have asked us to strive for it. By our own effort, it is difficult to achieve; it is a grace and it needs to be implored. Ask God for the strength to love. Say to Him: 'Lord, help me to love, teach me to forgive. I cannot do it alone, I need You.' Ask to see others not as hindrances but as brothers and sisters to be loved. We need to pray to learn how to love...to be truly Christian. For, according to Saint John of the Cross: 'in the evening of life, we will be judged on love.'"

May your Lenten journey result in a greater understanding and willingness to love according to the teachings of Jesus.

## **DESDE EL PASTOR**

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en El Señor:

En el Evangelio de San Mateo, Jesús enseña: "Has oído que se decía 'Amarás a tu prójimo y odiarás a tu enemigo'. Pero yo te digo, ama a tus enemigos y reza por los que te persiguen ..." (Mt .5: 43-44) El Papa Francisco habló recientemente sobre esta enseñanza de Cristo. Aquí hay parte de lo que dijo:

"Podríamos pensar que la enseñanza de Jesús es parte de un plan: al final, los malvados desistirán. Pero no es por eso que Jesús nos pide que amemos a los que nos hacen daño. ¿Cuál es, entonces, la razón? Es que el Padre, nuestro Padre, continúa amando a todos, incluso cuando Su amor no es correspondido. .... Jesús no señaló con el dedo a aquellos que lo condenaron injustamente y lo mataron cruelmente, sino que les abrió los brazos en la cruz. Y perdonó a los que clavaron clavos en sus muñecas (Lucas 23: 33-34)

"Si queremos ser discípulos de Cristo, si queremos llamarnos cristianos, esta es la única forma; no hay otro. Habiendo sido amados por Dios, estamos llamados a amar a cambio; habiendo sido perdonados, estamos llamados a perdonar; habiendo sido tocados por el amor, estamos llamados a amar sin esperar que otros amen primero; Habiendo sido salvados gentilmente, estamos llamados a no buscar ningún beneficio del bien que hacemos.

"... Ama a tus enemigos y reza por los que te persiguen. Esta es la innovación cristiana. Es la diferencia cristiana. Ore y ame: esto es lo que debemos hacer ... El amor de Jesús no conoce límites ni barreras. El Señor nos exige el coraje de tener un amor que no cuenta el costo; porque la medida de Jesús es amor sin medida ... En lo que concierne al mandato del amor universal, no aceptemos excusas ni prediquemos precaución prudente. El Señor no fue cauteloso; No cedió a compromisos. Nos pide el extremismo de la caridad. Este es el único tipo legítimo de extremismo cristiano: el extremismo del amor.

... Si la meta fuera imposible, el Señor no nos hubiera pedido que luchemos por alcanzarla. Por nuestro propio esfuerzo, es difícil de lograr; es una gracia y necesita ser implorada. Pídele a Dios la fuerza para amar. Dile: "Señor, ayúdame a amar, enséñame a perdonar. No puedo hacerlo solo, te necesito ". Pide ver a los demás no como obstáculos sino como hermanos y hermanas para ser amados. Necesitamos orar para aprender a amar ... para ser verdaderamente cristianos. Porque, según San Juan de la Cruz: "en la tarde de la vida, seremos juzgados por amor".

Que su viaje de Cuaresma resulte en una mayor comprensión y disposición para amar de acuerdo con las enseñanzas de Jesús.

### **La llamada Universal a la Santidad: 1a. Parte**

El Concilio Vaticano II habló de "llamada Universal a la Santidad, en su Constitución Dogmática sobre la Iglesia (Lumen Gentium); Con esta expresión se reconoce que todas las personas en el Pueblo de Dios estamos "llamadas a alcanzar la plenitud de la vida cristiana y la perfección en la caridad" (no. 40).

Esta llamada se dirige no solo a los

sacerdotes, diáconos y religiosos consagrados, sino también a los laicos, y debe asumirse dentro de la vocación personal específica de cada individuo (el matrimonio, la soltería, la maternidad y paternidad, etc.) Estamos llamados a ser santos viviendo nuestras vidas con amor y dando testimonio, en todo lo que hagamos y en cualquier lugar que nos encontremos. Llevar una vida santo es una forma poderosa de evangelizar el mundo. Debemos sin embargo contar con el hecho de que cometer errores es humano, y que solo con Dios podemos alcanzar la perfección

"No todo lo que un santo dice es totalmente fiel al Evangelio ni todo lo que él o ella hacen es auténtico o perfecto. Lo que debemos mirar en una persona santa es la totalidad de su vida, todo su camino de crecimiento en la fe, el resplandecer de Cristo que se refleja cuando miramos toda su persona." (Papa Francisco, Exhortación Apostólica: GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE. Llamada a la santidad en el mundo de hoy. Marzo 2018)

Por lo tanto, también nosotros debemos ver nuestra vida entera como una misión. A través de la oración y la petición debemos poder escuchar los signos que Dios nos da. Pida siempre al Espíritu Santo que le ilumine lo que Jesús espera de Usted en cada momento de su vida y en cada decisión que Usted debe hacer, así como poder discernir su lugar en la misión que ha recibido. Deje que el Espíritu forge en Usted la imagen de Cristo que Usted está llamado o llamada a ser en el mundo de hoy.

Sólo entonces Usted podrá percibir "Cuál es el mensaje de Jesús que Dios quiere que Usted anuncie al mundo a través de su vida. Déjese transformar. Déjese renovar por el Espíritu Santo para que ésto suceda y Usted no falle en su misión. El Señor lo conducirá a la plenitud a pesar de sus errores y malos pasos, siempre y cuando Usted no abandone el camino del amor y permanezca siempre abierto a su gracias sobrenatural, que purifica e ilumina." (GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE del Santo Padre, Francisco)

This call is directed not only to priests, deacons, and consecrated religious, but to the laity as well, and should be pursued within an individual's specific vocation (marriage, dedicated single life, parent, etc.). We are all called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do no matter where we find ourselves. Leading a holy life is one way the faithful can evangelize the world but it's important we recognize that mistakes are normal and we may falter occasionally.

"Not everything a saint says is completely faithful to the Gospel; not everything he or she does is authentic or perfect. What we need to contemplate is the totality of their life, their entire journey of growth in holiness, the reflection of Jesus Christ that emerges when we grasp their overall meaning as a person." (Apostolic Exhortation: GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE of the Holy Father Francis on the Call to Holiness in Today's World, March 2018)

Therefore, we too, must see our whole lives as a mission. Through prayer and petition, we must listen for God to recognize the signs he gives us. "Always ask the Spirit what Jesus expects from you at every moment of your life and in every decision you must make, so as to discern its place in the mission you have received. Allow the Spirit to forge in you the personal mystery that can reflect Jesus Christ in today's world."

Only then will we come to realize "...the message of Jesus that God wants to speak to the world by your life. Let yourself be transformed. Let yourself be renewed by the Spirit, so that this can happen, lest you fail in your precious mission. The Lord will bring it to fulfillment despite your mistakes and missteps, provided that you do not abandon the path of love but remain ever open to his supernatural grace, which purifies and enlightens."
