It's certainly enough to cause the viewer to say, "Thank You, God, for Your Love and Presence."

So let us all remember what gifts we have been given. Let us all be grateful to the One who loves us enough to make certain we have what we need. Let us all be willing to share those blessings with others so that each one of us knows what Love means and all of us can join together in saying, "Thank You, God, for Your Love and Presence."

Durante el tiempo que Él caminó entre nosotros, esas pequeñas aves fueron lo suficientemente importantes para las personas debido al hecho de que traer dos gorriones al Templo como una ofrenda de acción de gracias sería suficiente para cumplir con el requisito del Talmud de lo que alguien necesitaba presentar a Dios en agradecimiento por todo lo que Dios les había dado. We were assured by the Madison County Health Department that the process that we use was not an exposure problem, however those who serve at the sites were in danger of exposure. So we ceased providing volunteers at Alternatives and the Christian Center. As you are aware the soup kitchen ministry has not been able to collect food and monetary donations at church since February. Those involved in the collection process are not ready to return to that function at this time. The structure of Mass and social distancing are not compatible for our collection process. Universal Call to Holiness: Part 2

As discussed in part 1, the phrase ‘Universal Call to Holiness’ is stressed in the Second Vatican Council’s Dogmatic Constitution on the Church (Lumen Gentium); it recognizes that all the people of God are “called to the fullness of the Christian life and to the perfection of charity”

(no. 40).

This call is directed not only to priests, deacons, and consecrated religious, but to the laity as well, and should be pursued within an individual’s specific vocation (marriage, dedicated single life, parent, etc.). Following in Jesus’s footsteps in order to become more like Jesus is the path to holiness. We are all called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do. Leading a holy life is one way the faithful can evangelize the world. To achieve or even attempt to achieve holiness in this world can seem like an unattainable feat, however there are many practical ways each of us can grow in holiness every day. Here are a few examples:

- Attending Mass
- Receiving the Sacraments, especially reconciliation on a regular basis
- Praying daily and praying as a family/couple
- Meditation/Contemplation
- Eucharistic Adoration (spending an hour adoring the Blessed Sacrament)
- Lectio Divina (individually or in groups)
- Praying a daily Rosary
- Ignatian Daily Examen
- Fasting and sacrifice (giving something up for the sake of growing closer to Christ)
- Participating in charitable works (volunteering at a soup kitchen, collecting canned goods)
- Spreading the Gospel/talking to others about Jesus Christ

Llevando una vida santa es una forma a través de la cual los feligreses pueden evangelizar el mundo. Para conseguir o tratar de conseguir la santidad en este mundo, puede parecer algo inalcanzable, sin embargo, hay muchas maneras prácticas que cada uno de nosotros puede crecer en la santidad cada día. Aquí hay algunos ejemplos:

- Yendo a Misa
- Recibiendo los sacramentos,

especialmente yendo a la reconciliación regularmente

- Rezando diariamente en familia o con nuestra pareja
- Meditando/en contemplación
- La Adoración Eucarística (pasando una hora adorando al Santísimo Sacramento)
- Lectio Divina (de manera individual o en grupos)
- Rezando cada día el Santo Rosario
- Haciendo un examen Ignaciano diariamente
- Ayunando y sacrificando (renunciando a algo de tal manera que esto nos acerque más a Dios)
- Participando en actividades de caridad (ser voluntarios para darle de comer a los necesitados, recolectando comida para los más necesitados).
- Llevando por todos lados el Evangelio/hablándoles a los demás acerca de Jesucristo
