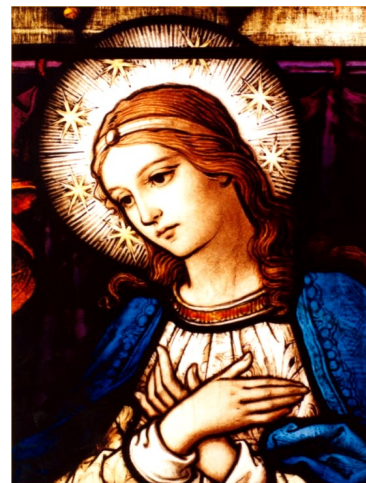

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

As most of you are aware, every Sunday at about 11:45 AM, Pope Francis addresses the members of the Faithful who have come to Rome on pilgrimage. He does so from the balcony of the Apostolic Palace that overlooks Saint Peter's Square. In a recent address, Pope Francis spoke about the importance of the month of June. Here is what he shared with the Faithful:

"The month of June is dedicated in a special way to the Heart of Christ, a devotion that unites the great spiritual teachers and the simple folk among the People of God. Indeed, the human and divine Heart of Jesus is the well-spring from which we can always draw upon God's mercy, forgiveness and tenderness. We can do so by focusing on a passage of the Gospel, feeling that at the center of every gesture, of every word of Jesus, at the center there is love, the love of the Father Who sent His Son, the love of the Holy Spirit that is within us. And we can do so by adoring the Eucharist, where this love is present in the Sacrament. Then our heart too, little by little, will become more patient, more generous, more merciful, in imitation of the Heart of Jesus.

"There is an ancient prayer—I learned it from my grandmother—which said: 'Jesus make my heart resemble Yours.' It is a beautiful prayer, 'Make my heart similar to Yours.' A beautiful and short prayer, to pray this month....I wish everyone a happy Sunday....Please, do not forget to pray for me....Arrivederci (let us meet again)."

Pope Francis reminds us that the more we focus on the merciful love of God; the more we understand the importance of mercy, forgiveness and acceptance among us all. I believe that what he hopes to teach us is that if we want to see an end to violence, to racism and to the animosity that seems to harbor at the edge of society; then we need to focus our attention elsewhere—away from quick judgements and prejudice; away from anger and resentment; and look for tolerance, acceptance and a willingness to see others as sisters and brothers in the Lord. May the "ancient prayer" of Pope Francis take root within our minds and hearts so that the knowledge and companionship of Jesus within us and among us may help us see everyone as a friend we have yet to meet and a companion on our journey to our common homeland—the Kingdom of God.

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en el Señor:

Como la mayoría de ustedes saben, todos los domingos alrededor de las 11:45 a.m., el Papa Francisco se dirige a los miembros de los Fieles que han venido a Roma en peregrinación. Lo hace desde el balcón del Palacio Apostólico que da a la Plaza de San Pedro. En un discurso reciente, el Papa Francisco habló sobre la importancia del mes de junio. Esto es lo que compartió con los fieles:

“El mes de junio está dedicado de manera especial al Corazón de Cristo, una devoción que une a los grandes maestros espirituales y la gente sencilla entre el Pueblo de Dios. De hecho, el corazón humano y divino de Jesús es el manantial del que siempre podemos recurrir a la misericordia, el perdón y la ternura de Dios. Podemos hacerlo enfocándonos en un pasaje del Evangelio, sintiendo que en el centro de cada gesto, de cada palabra de Jesús, en el centro hay amor, el amor del Padre que envió a su Hijo, el amor de lo Santo. Espíritu que está dentro de nosotros. Y podemos hacerlo adorando a la Eucaristía, donde este amor está presente en el Sacramento. Entonces nuestro corazón también, poco a poco, se volverá más paciente, más generoso, más misericordioso, imitando el Corazón de Jesús.

“Hay una oración antigua, la aprendí de mi abuela, que decía: 'Jesús hace que mi corazón se parezca al tuyo'. Es una oración hermosa, 'Haz que mi corazón sea similar al tuyo'. Una oración hermosa y corta, para rezar esto mes ... Les deseo a todos un feliz domingo ... Por favor, no olviden rezar por mí ... Arrivederci (reunámonos de nuevo) ”.

El Papa Francisco nos recuerda que cuanto más nos centramos en el amor misericordioso de Dios; cuanto más comprendemos la importancia de la misericordia, el perdón y la aceptación entre todos nosotros. Creo que lo que espera enseñarnos es que si queremos ver el fin de la violencia, el racismo y la animosidad que parece albergar al borde de la sociedad; entonces necesitamos enfocar nuestra atención en otra parte, lejos de juicios rápidos y prejuicios; lejos de la ira y el resentimiento; y busque tolerancia, aceptación y disposición para ver a los demás como hermanas y hermanos en el Señor. Que la "oración antigua" del Papa Francisco arraigue en nuestras mentes y corazones para que el conocimiento y la compañía de Jesús dentro de nosotros y entre nosotros nos ayuden a ver a todos como un amigo que aún tenemos que conocer y un compañero en nuestro viaje a nuestro patria común: el Reino de Dios.

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor: Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma: 1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556. 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana. 3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.



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
