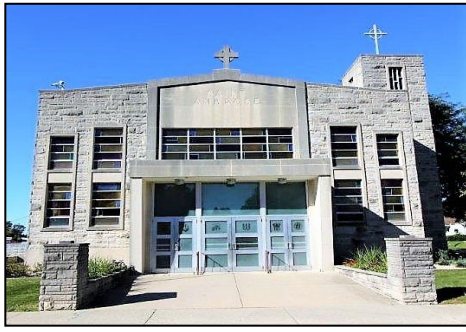

Off the Top of My Head...

Back in the early spring at Our Lady of Grace in Noblesville, I remember mentioning the need to start thinking about how we were going to make the transition back to “normal.” I knew that it would not be as simple as it sounded.

Although this was an important topic, a discussion was very premature. I, perhaps like many others, believed that we would be moving toward “normal” much sooner than has actually happened.

Now it’s time to start thinking about this again, here in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate. With announcements of two vaccines that may soon become available, we can say that there is a tiny, far-off light at the end of the tunnel.

I would not even care to guess about what timelines we should expect to follow. There is still much uncertainty, and the process will no doubt move slowly and imperfectly.

And we are hearing, from reliable resources, dire warnings about the next two or three months. So our primary focus must be on continuing the practices that are proven to help stop the spread of the virus: Social distancing, wearing masks in public, avoiding crowds, staying home when ill (and maybe even when healthy!), and regular handwashing/sanitizing.

And we will need to continue to focus on each other – making phone calls, checking in, helping out where we can, and supporting each other in multiple ways, even more so now than in the early days of the pandemic. I’m afraid that we have become numb to the numbers; a death toll of 275,000 is too mind-boggling to consider. So we need to intentionally recommit ourselves to the care and the carefulness that marked the beginning of the pandemic.

At the same time, we need to start thinking about making that transition back to fuller participation in the life and ministry of our parishes. And as we do that, we should also be thinking about what we have learned during this time that may help us to enhance our parishes’ life and ministry “post-Covid.”

I, for one, am looking forward to restoring the Sign of Peace, having meetings with six people at one table, shaking hands and hugging, and maybe a big mask-burning party.

But first things first.

This kind of waiting is similar to that which Advent calls us. Of course, what we truly await is not a vaccine, but a Savior.

A principios de la primavera en Our Lady of Grace en Noblesville, recuerdo haber mencionado la necesidad de comenzar a pensar en cómo íbamos a hacer la transición de regreso a la “normalidad”. Sabía que no sería tan simple como parecía.

Aunque este fue un tema importante, una discusión fue muy prematura. Yo, tal vez como muchos otros, creí que estaríamos avanzando hacia lo “normal” mucho antes de lo que realmente sucedió.

Ahora es el momento de empezar a pensar en esto de nuevo, aquí en la Pastoral Anderson-Alexandria. Con los anuncios de dos vacunas que pronto estarán disponibles, podemos decir que hay una luz diminuta y lejana al final del túnel.

Ni siquiera me importaría adivinar qué líneas de tiempo deberíamos esperar seguir. Todavía hay mucha incertidumbre y sin duda el proceso avanzará lenta e imperfectamente.

Y estamos escuchando, de fuentes confiables, advertencias espantosas sobre los próximos dos o tres meses. Por lo tanto, nuestro enfoque principal debe ser continuar con las prácticas que han demostrado ayudar a detener la propagación del virus: distanciamiento social, uso de máscaras en público, evitar multitudes, quedarse en casa cuando está enfermo (¡y tal vez incluso cuando está sano!) Y lavarse las manos con regularidad. desinfectar.

Y tendremos que seguir enfocándonos el uno en el otro, haciendo llamadas telefónicas, registrándose, ayudando donde podamos y apoyándonos mutuamente de múltiples maneras, incluso más ahora que en los primeros días de la pandemia.

Me temo que nos hemos vuelto insensibles a los números; un número de muertos de 275.000 es demasiado abrumador para considerarlo. Por lo tanto, debemos volver a comprometernos intencionalmente con el cuidado y el cuidado que marcó el comienzo de la pandemia.

Al mismo tiempo, debemos comenzar a pensar en hacer esa transición de regreso a una participación más plena en la vida y el ministerio de nuestras parroquias. Y mientras hacemos eso, también deberíamos pensar en lo que hemos aprendido durante este tiempo que puede ayudarnos a mejorar la vida y el ministerio de nuestras parroquias "post-Covid".

Yo, por mi parte, estoy ansioso por restaurar el Signo de la Paz, tener reuniones con seis personas en una mesa, estrechar la mano y abrazar, y tal vez una gran fiesta para quemar máscaras.

Pero lo primero es lo primero.

Este tipo de espera es similar al que nos llama el Adviento. Por supuesto, lo que realmente esperamos no es una vacuna, sino un Salvador.

¡Ven, Señor Jesús!

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor: If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556. 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor: Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma: 1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556. 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana. 3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901. 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.

No matter what our perspective or response to change may be, earthly living requires us to confront change from time to time. Life never stands still.

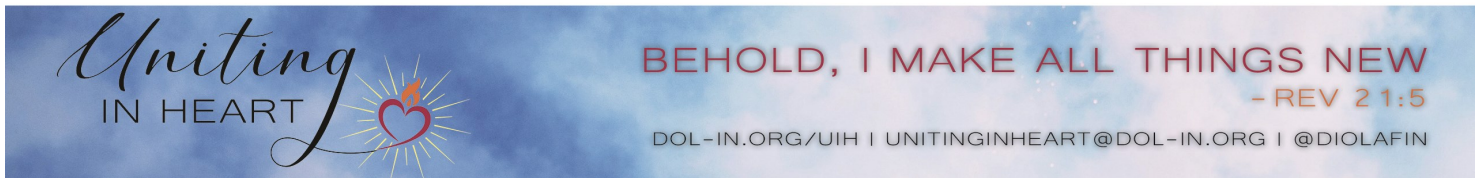
