Off the Top of My Head...

Last Monday, staff and lay leaders from the three parishes of the Pastorate took part in a webinar entitled "A 'Welcome Back' Plan for the Parishes in the Diocese of Lafayette in Indiana." It gave parish leaders an opportunity to brainstorm about a plan for "reopening" as the Covid Pandemic begins to wane.

One of the key elements of the suggested plan was regular communication from the Pastor, and beyond bulletin columns and emails there will be periodic mailings to all parishioners, beginning sometime after Easter. A couple of other elements include some sort of welcome back celebration and an opportunity to remember in prayer those who died during the pandemic, whether or not Covid was the cause. There were plenty of other good ideas and I'm looking forward to putting some of them into practice. (Personally, I'm still holding out for a Pastorate-wide mask burning party!)

Meanwhile, as the numbers continue to trend down, we need to remember that they are still high. According to the State of Indiana's Covid website, there were 32 deaths in the state caused by Covid between February 21 and March 10. Because that number is lower than past numbers, we may be tempted to say that only 32 people died during that period. But, although lower, it's still a high number. So continued vigilance and care are needed. Every week until further notice, our bulletin will include a reminder and information about receiving the Covid vaccine. I pray that every eligible person in our Pastorate will take advantage of the opportunity as it arises. As more people are vaccinated, we anticipate an increase in Mass attendance. This is a "good problem." We will need to balance two legitimate needs — the need for social distancing and the need to worship. Please be patient and keep parish leadership in your prayers as we seek the best options!

Speaking of worship, remember that the Easter Triduum liturgies at all three parishes will be on Holy Thursday at 7:00 pm, Good Friday at 7:00 pm, and Holy Saturday at 8:15 pm. We are STILL working on the Easter Sunday schedule as I am typing up this column. We hope to have that announced soon.

Two more weeks until Holy Week! Keep on fasting, praying, and serving!

Reflexión Del Padre Tom....

El pasado lunes, personal y líderes laicos de las tres parroquias de la Pastoral participaron en un webinar titulado "Un plan de bienvenida de regreso" para las parroquias de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana". Les dio la oportunidad a los líderes de las parroquias de intercambiar ideas sobre un plan para la "reapertura" a medida que la pandemia de COVID comienza a disminuir.

Uno de los elementos clave del plan sugerido fue la comunicación regular del Pastor, y anuncios en los boletines y el envió de correos electrónicos habituales a todos los feligreses, comenzando después de la pascua. Otros elementos incluyen algún tipo de celebración de bienvenida y una oportunidad para recordar en oración a los que murieron durante la pandemia, ya fuera de Covid u otra causa.

Hubo muchas otras buenas ideas y estoy deseando poner algunas de ellas en práctica. (¡Personalmente, todavía estoy esperando una fiesta de quema de máscaras en todo el Pastorado!)

Mientras tanto, a medida que los números continúan bajando, debemos recordar que aún son altos. Según el sitio web COVID del estado de Indiana, hubo 32 muertes en el estado causadas por COVID entre el 21 de febrero al 10 de marzo. Debido a que ese número es más bajo que los números anteriores, es posible decir que SOLO 32 personas murieron durante este período. Pero, aunque sea un número menor, sigue siendo un número elevado. Por lo tanto, Continuemos vigilando y seguir con los cuidando continuos.

Cada semana hasta nuevo aviso, nuestro boletín incluirá un recordatorio e información sobre la recepción del Vacuna del COVID-19. Orar para que cada persona elegible en nuestro Pastorado aproveche la oportunidad.

A medida que se vacunen más personas, anticipamos un aumento en la asistencia a misa. Este es un "problema bueno". Necesitaremos equilibrar dos necesidades legítimas: la necesidad de distanciamiento social y la necesidad de adorar. ¡Sea paciente y mantenga el liderazgo parroquial en sus oraciones mientras buscamos las mejores opciones! Hablando de adoración, recuerde que las liturgias del Triduo Pascual en las tres parroquias serán el día Jueves Santos a las 7:00 pm, Viernes Santo a las 7:00 pm y Sábado Santo a las 8:15 pm. TODAVÍA estamos trabajando en el horario del Domingo de Pascua mientras estoy escribiendo esta columna. Espero que se anuncie pronto. ¡Dos semanas más hasta Semana Santa! ¡Sigan ayunando, orando y sirviendo!

Important D of I Meeting at St. Mary, Alexandria


The Daughters of Isabella (D of I) St. Elizabeth Seton circle will be meeting on **Tuesday, March 16 at 6:00PM** in Zimmer Hall. All current members are encouraged to attend. Discussions will focus on the next steps in the formation of the new parish women's ministry. Topics will include (but not limited to) the scope of the new ministry, the review of proposed bylaws, and more. **Materials about the new proposed ministry will be available in the narthex of the church for current D of I members to review prior to this meeting.** If attending the meeting in person, please be sure to wear a mask and plan to follow the current COVID guidelines followed by the church. As a reminder to all current members and as a general notification to the parish: the Daughters of Isabella (D of I) St. Elizabeth Seton circle is sadly being disbanded after nearly 100 years at the parish. Members present at a meeting held late in 2020 voted unanimously to disband the local D of I circle. Also unanimously agreed upon was the need to create a new women's ministry or group. 
