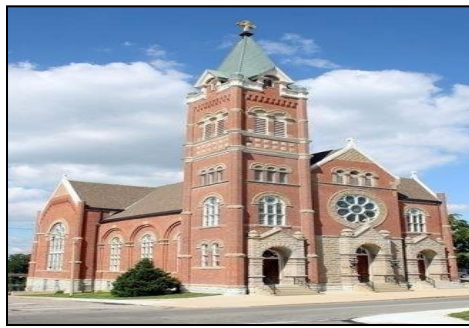

Off the Top of My Head...

Last week I wrote about a prayer intention which was originally intended to be included at Mass, but which I decided to omit. It was a prayer for unarmed people killed in police actions. I had composed it for the weekend Masses. I mentioned that for some people, this prayer may have sounded like a prayer against police. But I proposed the following comparison: Just as a prayer for the victims of clergy sex abuse is not a prayer against clergy, prayer for unarmed victims of police actions is not a prayer against police. (I realize that this comparison may or may not be convincing to everyone.) We can consider how other prayer intentions might be subject to similar interpretations, as follows. (These examples are not an exercise in sarcasm.)

When we pray for God's blessings on mothers, how do those prayers affect women with fertility issues or people whose mothers deserted or physically abused them? When we pray for the divorced, how do these prayers sound to the married couples in the assembly? Or when we pray for those who are married, how does that feel to the divorced? When we pray against abortion, what might be happening in the heart of a woman who had an abortion years ago and, finally getting past the shame, has worked up the courage to come to the Mass when this prayer intention was announced?

When we pray for African-American victims of racism, are we excluding Hispanic or Asian victims? Are we praying against "all white people" as racists? When we pray for the success of Catholic schools, are we praying for the failure of the public schools? When we pray for immigrants, are we praying against citizens and residents? When we pray for persecuted Christians, are we excluding non-Christians persecuted for their faith?

Even the most positive and uplifting prayer intention can be experienced (or interpreted) as a source of pain (or at least discomfort) in a way that was not originally envisioned. Sometimes prayer is very comforting. Sometimes prayer can make us very uncomfortable. (Remember the prayer of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane: "Father, thy will be done.")

Some "uncomfortable prayers" can be really good for us as persons and as a community. Again as I conclude this column, I realize that this topic requires still more reflection. Next week, the third, and (I hope!), final chapter of the story.

Pensamiento del padre Tom...

La semana pasada escribí sobre una intención de oración que originalmente estaba destinada a incluirse en la misa, pero que decidí omitir. Fue una oración por las personas desarmadas asesinadas en acciones policiales. Lo, había compuesto para las misas de fin de semana. Mencione que, para algunas personas, esta oración puede haber sonado como una oración contra la policía. Pero propongo la siguiente comparación: así como una oración por las víctimas de abuso sexual del clero NO es una oración contra el clero, la oración por las víctimas desarmadas de policiales NO es una oración contra la policía. (Me doy cuenta de que esta comparación NO puede resultar convincente para todos). Podemos considerar cómo otras oraciones pueden estar sujetas a interpretaciones similares. (Estos ejemplos NO son sarcasmo).

Cuando oramos para que Dios bendiga a las madres, ¿cómo es que estas oraciones afectan a las mujeres con problemas de fertilidad o a las personas cuyas madres las abandonaron o abusaron físicamente de ellas? Cuando oramos por los divorciados, ¿cómo les suenan estas oraciones a las parejas casadas en la asamblea? O cuando oramos por los casados, ¿cómo se sienten los divorciados? Cuando oramos contra el aborto, ¿qué podría estar sucediendo en el corazón de una mujer que tuvo un aborto hace años y, finalmente ha superado la vergüenza, ha reunido el valor para asistir a Misa escucho esta intención de oración?

Cuando oramos por las víctimas afroamericanas que han sufrido racismo, ¿estamos excluyendo a las víctimas hispanas o asiáticas? ¿Estamos rezando contra "toda la gente blanca" como racistas? Cuando oramos por el éxito de las escuelas católicas, ¿estamos orando por el fracaso de las escuelas públicas? Cuando oramos por los inmigrantes, ¿Estamos orando en contra de los ciudadanos o residentes? Cuando oramos por los cristianos perseguidos, ¿Estamos excluyendo a los que no son cristianos y que son perseguidos por su fe?

Incluso la intención de oración más positiva y edificante puede experimentarse (o interpretarse) como una fuente de dolor (o malestar) de una manera que no se había previsto originalmente. A veces, la oración es muy reconfortante. A veces, la oración puede hacernos sentir muy incómodos. (Recuerden la oración de Jesús en el Huerto de Getsemaní: "Padre, hágase tu voluntad".) Algunas "oraciones incómodas" pueden ser muy buenas para nosotros como personas y como comunidad. Una vez más, al concluir esta columna, me doy cuenta de que este tema requiere aún más reflexión. La semana que viene, el tercer y ¡espero!) sea el último Capítulo de la historia.

SUMMER MASS SCHEDULE: As summer arrives, we will be making some changes in our weekday Mass schedule due to our priests’ absences. The diocesan Priests’ Convocation takes place June 7-10 and all three priests are participating. The priests are planning on some vacation time and Fr. Dave Hellmann will be having knee replacement surgery. (Please keep him in your prayers!) In addition, now that school is out, we are moving the Masses on Thursday and Friday back to 8:00 am until the new school year begins at Holy Cross School in Anderson. Finally, the diocesan ordination Mass is on Saturday, June 5, and there will be no 1:00 pm confessions at St. Mary’s in Anderson that day. Confused? Think of how confused the priests were as they worked on this schedule!

Here’s what to expect for the next two months:

- Saturday, June 5: NO 1:00 pm Confessions at St. Mary’s, Anderson
- Tuesday through Thursday, June 8-10: No Masses at any parishes in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate
- Beginning June 14 and ending September 3: Weekday Masses are as follows:
- Monday: 8:00, St. Ambrose (no Mass at St. Mary’s, Anderson)
- Tuesday: 8:00, St. Ambrose
- Wednesday: 8:00, St. Mary’s, Alexandria and St. Ambrose
- Thursday: 8:00*, St. Mary’s, And. (no Mass at St. Ambrose)
- Friday: 8:00*, St. Mary’s, Alexandria, and St. Ambrose
- ** Thursday’s Mass at 8:00 will move to 8:30 from July 29, and Friday’s Mass at 8:00 will move to 8:10 from July 30, the first week of classes at Holy Cross.

THE DISPENSATION FROM THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS IS BEING LIFTED:

Beginning June 12-13, 2021, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is lifted throughout the state of Indiana. This means that, except for the unique situations as described below, those who are otherwise healthy are obliged to participate in Sunday Mass beginning the weekend of June 12-13, 2021. The exceptions are:

- Those who are seriously ill, exhibit flu-like symptoms and/or may have a contagious disease (including quarantine due to exposure).
- Those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own (e.g. transportation issue).
- Those who are homebound and/or incapacitated due to age, infirmity and/or medical restrictions.
- Those who have compromised health conditions and/or at high risk of contracting the virus.
- Those who are caretakers of person who are sick or of persons at high-risk of serious illness if they contract Covid virus.

If you have any questions about any specific needs, concerns or protocols, you are advised to contact the parish directly. As your pastor, Fr. Tom has the authority to dispense in individual cases and he and Fr. Marty and Fr. Dave can be helpful in addressing individual fears and concerns.

SE LEVANTA LA DISPENSACIÓN DE LA OBLIGACIÓN DOMINICAL DE ASISTIR A LA MISA:

A partir del 12 y 13 de junio de 2021, se levanta la dispensa general de la obligación de asistir a la Misa en todo el estado de Indiana. Esto significa que, a excepción de situaciones únicas que se describen a continuación, aquellos que por lo demás están sanos están obligados a participar en misa dominical a partir del fin de semana del 12 y 13 de junio de 2021. Las excepciones son:

- Aquellos que están gravemente enfermos, presentan síntomas similares a los de la gripe y / o pueden tener una enfermedad contagiosa (incluyendo la cuarentena debido a la exposición).
- Aquellos que no pueden asistir a Misa por causas ajenas a su voluntad (por ejemplo, problemas de transporte).
- Aquellos que están confinados en casa y / o discapacitados debido a la edad, enfermedad y / o restricciones médicas.
- Aquellos que tienen condiciones de salud comprometidas y / o con alto riesgo de contraer el virus.
- Aquellos que son cuidadores de personas enfermas o de personas con alto riesgo de enfermedades graves si contraen el virus Covid.

Si tiene alguna pregunta sobre necesidades, inquietudes o protocolos específicos, le recomendamos que se comunique directamente con la parroquia. Como su pastor, el P. Tom tiene la autoridad para dispensar en casos individuales y él y el P. Marty y el P. Dave puede ser útil para abordar los miedos y preocupaciones individuales.

A medida que llega el verano, haremos algunos cambios en nuestro horario de la Misa que se celebra durante la semana debido a las ausencias de nuestros sacerdotes.
