Off the Top of My Head...

As you know, the dispensation from participating in weekend Mass has been lifted, and with the return of the Sunday Mass obligation, each parish in the Diocese of Lafayette is implementing updated protocols to help minimize the spread of the Covid virus. Bishop Doherty has given each pastor the discretion for these decisions as the situation differs from one area to the other.

In our three parishes of St. Mary's Alexandria, St. Ambrose, and St. Mary's Anderson, we have gone from "mandatory" to "optional but encouraged" regarding the use of masks, hand sanitizer, and social distancing. One requirement which is mandatory, however, is the "masks required" sections of pews in each church at all the English Masses in the Pastorate.

These sections are reserved for the use of those who wish to continue wearing masks when they come to Mass. Those wearing masks are not REQUIRED to use those pews, but those NOT wearing masks MAY NOT use them. I ask everyone who chooses not to wear a mask to honor that requirement.

The people who wear masks and use those pews are intentionally choosing to do so because they want to continue following the practices that have kept them and many other people safe throughout the many months of the pandemic. They use those pews with the expectation that everyone else using those pews will also be following those practices, including using a mask.

In requiring that everyone using those pews wear a mask, there is no intention to limit anyone's freedom or to hinder anyone's ability to participate in the Mass. The intention is to respect the health needs and concerns of those who desire to continue wearing a mask at this time. Those who intentionally sit in the "masks required" pews while not wearing a mask are causing discomfort, at the very least, to the masked participants who are using that section.

During the 11:30 Sunday Mass at St. Mary Anderson, because the large majority of the Hispanic community prefers to wear masks the entire main church is reserved for those wearing masks. In the church annex, masks are encouraged but not required.

I hope this communication has helped to make more clear the reason for our "masks required" sections of pews, and the importance of complying with the requirement of wearing a mask in those pews.

Como saben, se ha levantado la dispensa de participar en la misa de fin de semana y, con el regreso de la obligación de la misa dominical, cada parroquia de la Diócesis de Lafayette está implementando protocolos actualizados para ayudar a minimizar la propagación del virus Covid. El obispo Doherty le ha dado a cada pastor la discreción de tomar estas decisiones ya que la situación es diferente para cada área.

En nuestras tres parroquias de St. María Alexandria, St. Ambrosio y St. María Anderson, hemos pasado de "obligatorio" a "opcional pero alentado" con respecto al uso de máscaras, desinfectante de manos y distanciamiento social. Un requisito que es obligatorio, sin embargo, son las secciones de bancas de cada iglesia con "máscaras requeridas" en todas las misas en inglés en la Pastoral.

Estas secciones están reservadas para el uso de aquellos que deseen seguir usando máscaras cuando vienen a Misa. Aquellos que usan máscaras no están REQUERIDOS de usar esos bancos, pero aquellos que NO usan máscaras NO PUEDEN usarlos.

Les pido a todos los que eligen no usar una máscara de cumplir con este requisito.

Las personas que usan máscaras y usan esos bancos están eligiendo intencionalmente hacerlo porque quieren continuar siguiendo las prácticas que los han mantenido a ellos y a muchas otras personas a salvo durante los muchos meses de la pandemia. Usan esos bancos con la expectativa de que todos los demás que usen esos bancos también sigan las mismas prácticas, incluido el uso de una máscara.

Al exigir que todos los que usen esos bancos usen una máscara, no hay ninguna intención de limitar la libertad de nadie ni obstaculizar la capacidad de nadie para participar en la Misa. La intención es respetar las necesidades e inquietudes de salud de quienes deseen seguir usando una máscara. Aquellos que se sientan intencionalmente en los bancos de "máscaras requeridas" sin usar una máscara están causando incomodidad, al menos, a los participantes con mascaras que están usando esa sección.

Durante la misa dominical de las 11:30 en St. Maria Anderson, debido a que la gran mayoría de la comunidad hispana prefiere usar máscaras, toda la iglesia principal está reservada para quienes usan máscaras. En el anexo de la iglesia, se fomentan las máscaras, pero no son obligatorias.

Espero que este comunicado haya ayudado a aclarar el motivo de nuestras secciones de bancos de "máscaras requeridas" y la importancia de cumplir con el requisito de usar una máscara en esos bancos.

Remember Our Summer Weekday Mass Schedule

For the parishes in Anderson: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, 8:00 am at St. Ambrose only. Thursday, 8:00 am at St. Mary's Anderson only.

This schedule is in effect until the last week of July, when the new school year starts at Holy Cross school.

There are no changes in the weekday Mass schedule at St. Mary's Alexandria.

NEW COVID PROTOCOLS: All Catholics, with exceptions for obvious health reasons, will be obliged to participate in Sunday Masses. For more information, see the website of the Diocese of Lafayette in Indiana, <https://dol-in.org/covid-19-updates>. The following COVID protocols will be in place in Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate.

All Masses except 11:30 am:

- One section of pews in each church will be reserved for those wearing masks. In that section, every other pew will be closed to enable social distancing. Note that those wearing masks are not REQUIRED to sit in that section, but anyone using that section must wear a mask and practice social distancing.
- In the remainder of the pews, masks will be optional and every pew will be available for use.

11:30 Mass only:

- In the main church and in the balcony, masks will be required and every second pew closed.
- In the church annex, masks will be encouraged but optional.

At all Masses:

- The use of masks, hand sanitizer, and social distancing are still strongly encouraged for all, in order to stop the spread of the COVID virus, especially during Communion. Masks and hand sanitizer will continue to be supplied by the parishes.
- Clergy and Communion Ministers will wear masks and use hand sanitizer before and after distributing Communion.
- As the COVID virus is transmitted primarily through exposure to respiratory fluids, until further notice clergy and lay Communion Ministers will continue to distribute Communion only in the hand.
- At that point when we begin taking up the collection during Mass, ushers will wear masks while passing the basket.
- The Sign of Peace is reinstated and should take place without physical contact (e.g. a bow of the head or a wave).
- Spray disinfectant will no longer be applied after the Masses.

Rosary at the Grotto (St. Mary Alexandria)- Everyone is invited to join the parishioners of St. Mary, Alexandria for our annual Rosary at the Grotto event which is held on the 13th of each month through October at 7:00 PM. Plan to gather at the outside parish grotto (to the west of the school playground) to recite the rosary for the intentions of Our Blessed Mother and to pray for peace in the world. This year, to commemorate the Year of St. Joseph, we also plan to recite a litany to St. Joseph. Bring blankets and/or your lawn chairs and be sure to dress for outdoor weather. In case of stormy weather, the rosary will be recited in the church.

Father's Day Prayers and Votive Candles

As Father's Day is this weekend let's ask St. Joseph's guidance and strength for all the men who are fathers, step-fathers, foster fathers, fathers-to-be, or who mentor like fathers to others. We also pray for deceased fathers. Say a rosary or offer special prayers and then light a candle in the Narthex of St. Mary (Alexandria). Place \$2/candle (or \$5 for 3 candles) in the collection basket and mark the offering as "candles." St. Joseph, pray for us and pray for all fathers—living and deceased.

UNITING IN HEART TEAM

Last month the first wave of Pastorate Leadership Teams completed their six team building workshops with Our Sunday Visitor (OSV). Here you can read a little about the six topics covered. To hear more about their experience, read the article in the June 6 edition of *The Catholic Moment*.

Managing Change

- **Change Style for Leadership:** A workshop reviewing the 3 types of profiles of how one may experience change. Understanding the differences of how change is embraced leads to implementing change well. The Change Style Indicator Assessment is a key part of this course.
- **Navigating Change:** A workshop designed to assist with the implementation of change when a change is occurring. This training assists leaders and individuals in understanding what stage of change they are in and how to move forward towards acceptance.

UNITING IN HEART TEAM

Manejando el Cambio

- **Cambio de estilo para el liderazgo:** un taller que repasa los 3 tipos de perfiles de cómo se puede experimentar el cambio. Comprender las diferencias de cómo se acepta el cambio conduce a implementarlo bien. La Evaluación del Indicador de Cambio de estilo es una parte clave de este curso.
- **Navegando por el cambio:** un taller diseñado para ayudar con la implementación del cambio cuando se está produciendo un cambio. Esta capacitación ayuda a los líderes y las personas a comprender en qué etapa de cambio se encuentran y cómo avanzar hacia la aceptación.

Conversational Intelligence

- **The Neuroscience of Conversations:** This workshop provides an in-depth view of how words and conversations have power and meaning that can trigger trust or distrust. It also covers the neurochemicals that are stimulated by our words and what part of our brains are activated.

- **Elevating Team Trust:** Using a T.R.U.S.T model, this workshop guides teams with building positive relationships using truth with grace.

• **III Levels of Conversations:** This workshop reviews 3 different types of conversations, which all have healthy aspects to them, but also unhealthy components. Insight into what may occur when we communicate within those blind spots are key takeaways. Participants also learn to co-create and tap into a part of their brain that sparks creativity, great thinking, and trust.

Listening Intelligence

- This workshop delves into the cognitive behavioral functions of listening and how we all listen to and for different things. When we understand how others listen differently, communication is improved. The assessment provides an individual profile of a person's listening preferences.

Managing Conflict

- **Reducing Workplace Conflict:** A workshop designed to review constructive behaviors, destructive behaviors, and hot buttons (values near and dear to our heart) during times of conflict. The workshop

provides essential leadership strategies to manage conflict in an effective manner. The Conflict Dynamic Profile provides an individualized assessment of how one experiences and reacts to conflict.

- **Proactive Conflict Resolution for Teams:** This workshop provides Leaders and teams essential skills in proactively addressing Conflict. It reviews techniques for effective communication skills during these challenging times.

Emotional Intelligence and the EQ-I 2.0 Assessment:

- This workshop along with the assessment evaluates both emotional and social intelligence, as well as the emotional competencies of an individual. The session along with the assessment provides understanding within 5 composites, with 3 elements within each composite. The 5 composites are Self-Perception, Self-Expression, Interpersonal, Decision Making, and Stress Management.

Working Styles and Personality Preferences Using Myers Briggs:

- This workshop provides a self-assessment for attendees to determine how they are energized, how they take in and perceive information, how they make decisions, and how they approach the outside world. Several activities allow the team to better understand one another's working styles, how they communicate best, and how they approach their work.

La inteligencia emocional y la evaluación EQ-I 2.0:

La sesión junto con la evaluación proporciona comprensión dentro de 5 componentes, con 3 elementos dentro de cada componente. Los 5 componentes son Autopercepción, Autoexpresión, Interpersonal, Toma de decisiones y Manejo del estrés.

Estilos de trabajo y preferencias de personalidad con Myers Briggs:

- Este taller proporciona una autoevaluación a los asistentes para determinar cómo se sienten energizados, cómo captan y perciben la información, cómo toman decisiones y cómo se acercan al mundo exterior. Varias actividades permiten que el equipo comprenda mejor los estilos de trabajo de los demás, cómo se comunican mejor y cómo enfocan su trabajo.
