A Reflection

Our readings today remind us to live our lives in total surrender to God's care.

The Gospel recounts when Jesus instructs His twelve apostles to begin their missionary work two by two. He encouraged them to take very little — a walking stick and sandals.

If you can recall a time you packed for a trip, or even left the house for a day's travel, you might remember making a list or packing days in advance. We tend to pack so we know we will be comfortable.

If we extend this concept of "comfort" into other areas of our lives, we will most likely find a few instances where we ensure life is comfortable. It could be buying extra food at the grocery store, making sure we have the most updated technology, or even feeling safe in our bank accounts.

It is not bad to have extra food in the pantry or a new phone. And it isn't bad to save money. These things can be good when used properly.

But what if we are looking to these things for comfort, security or even happiness?

Imagine if Jesus approached you and said, "Go out and do my work, but you can only bring a walking stick and shoes." Would you be willing to surrender all the rest?

A key component of living out our call as Christian stewards is total surrender. It is trusting in God during our best moments and our hardest. It is looking to Him for security, comfort and happiness.

Reflect on the ways you might be looking for comfort in the things of this world. Tangibly find a way to become independent from that "thing" so that you can become more dependent on God.

No está mal tener comida extra en la despensa o un teléfono nuevo. Y no está mal ahorrar dinero. Estas cosas pueden ser buenas cuando se usan correctamente.

Pero, ¿qué pasa si buscamos estas cosas en busca de comodidad, seguridad o incluso felicidad?

Imagínese si Jesús se le acerca y le dijera: "Sal y haz mi trabajo, pero solo puedes traer un bastón y zapatos".

¿Estarías dispuesto a entregar todo el resto?

Un componente clave para vivir nuestro llamado como mayordomos cristianos es la entrega total. Es confiar en Dios en nuestros mejores momentos y en los más duros. Está buscando en Él en busca de seguridad, consuelo y felicidad.

Reflexione sobre las formas en que podría estar buscando consuelo en las cosas de este mundo. Encuentre de manera tangible una manera de independizarse de esa "cosa" para que pueda volverse más dependiente de Dios.

Remember Our Summer Weekday Mass Schedule

For the parishes in Anderson: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, 8:00 am at St. Ambrose only. Thursday, 8:00 am at St. Mary's Anderson only.

This schedule is in effect until the last week of July, when the new school year starts at Holy Cross School.

There are **no changes** in the weekday Mass schedule at St. Mary's Alexandria.

NEW COVID PROTOCOLS: All Catholics, with exceptions for obvious health reasons, will be obliged to participate in Sunday Masses. For more information, see the website of the Diocese of Lafayette in Indiana, <https://dol-in.org/covid-19-updates>. The following COVID protocols will be in place in Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate.

All Masses except 11:30 am:

- One section of pews in each church will be reserved for those wearing masks. In that section, every other pew will be closed to enable social distancing. Note that those wearing masks are not REQUIRED to sit in that section, but anyone using that section must wear a mask and practice social distancing.
- In the remainder of the pews, masks will be optional and every pew will be available for use.

11:30 Mass only:

- In the main church and in the balcony, masks will be required and every second pew closed.
- In the church annex, masks will be encouraged but optional.

At all Masses:

- The use of masks, hand sanitizer, and social distancing are still strongly encouraged for all, in order to stop the spread of the COVID virus, especially during Communion. Masks and hand sanitizer will continue to be supplied by the parishes.
- Clergy and Communion Ministers will wear masks and use hand sanitizer before and after distributing Communion.
- As the COVID virus is transmitted primarily through exposure to respiratory fluids, until further notice clergy and lay Communion Ministers will continue to distribute Communion only in the hand.
- At that point when we begin taking up the collection during Mass, ushers will wear masks while passing the basket.
- The Sign of Peace is reinstated and should take place without physical contact (e.g. a bow of the head or a wave).
- Spray disinfectant will no longer be applied after the Masses.

Rosary at the Grotto (St. Mary Alexandria)- Everyone is invited to join the parishioners of St. Mary, Alexandria for our annual Rosary at the Grotto event which is held on the 13th of each month through October at 7:00 PM. Plan to gather at the outside parish grotto (to the west of the school playground) to recite the rosary for the intentions of Our Blessed Mother and to pray for peace in the world. This year, to commemorate the Year of St. Joseph, we also plan to recite a litany to St. Joseph. Bring blankets and/or your lawn chairs and be sure to dress for outdoor weather. In case of stormy weather, the rosary will be recited in the church.

UNITING IN HEART TEAM

The following is an excerpt from the June 20 edition of *The Catholic Moment*.

In 2017, Our Sunday Visitor (OSV) launched its Parish Vision Planning solution with Katie Herzing serving as Parish Coach. Our vision planning model employed the use of a coach to guide and direct parish vision planning teams through the process and in the months following the presentation of a plan to ensure that it remained a living, breathing document relevant to parish life.

What is a Pastorate Vision Plan?

A Pastorate Vision Plan is a written, easy-

to-read document that outlines how the pastorate intends to grow over the course of the next three years. This document will be focused on how each pastorate is living the three pillars of Uniting in Heart: Mission, Community, and Witness. Through a series of meetings with the Pastorate Consultant and OSV Coach, the team will discern their pastorate goals and milestones for the next three years.

Creating the Plan

The Pastoral Vision Planning process begins by soliciting the input of the parishioners of each pastorate. The intention of the survey is to give each member of the pastorate an opportunity to share their experience, provide feedback, indicate their future needs, and share a little about their faith life. These results are compiled by the team at OSV and presented to the Vision Planning Team at each pastorate.

The members of the Vision Planning Team review the results, read through all of the comments, and discuss the overarching areas where they want to focus the future plan. Then, the team holds a "Big Brainstorming Session" fueled by ideas, post-its, and conversation all centered on the major areas of focus decided on by the Vision Planning

Team and the Missionary Pastor in consultation with the Pastorate Consultant. The team engages in a few rounds of brainstorming to write goals for each focus area and then outline potential milestones (concrete actions) to help the pastorate achieve those goals over the course of the next three years.

Sharing the Plan

The Pastorate Consultant and the OSV Coach will work closely with the Missionary Pastor and Vision Planning Team to ensure that the goals are specific, measurable, aligned with Uniting in Heart, realistic for the pastorate, and bound to the three-year time frame. This plan answers the question, "What does Uniting in Heart look like at our pastorate?"

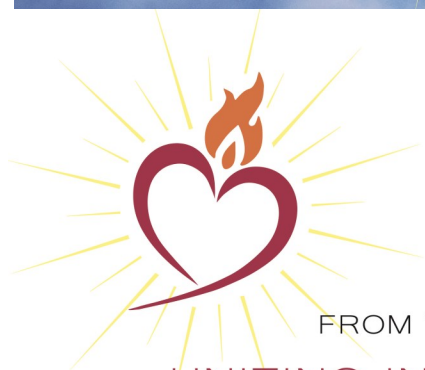
Because the mission of Uniting in Heart encompasses all aspects of pastorate and faith life, there's something in the Pastorate Vision Plan for everyone to participate in. This might be leading a new ministry or attending a new opportunity to be formed as a missionary disciple. It could be meeting the needs of someone in the community or praying for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the people of the pastorate. Every person has a role to play in the future of the faith!

UNITING IN HEART TEAM

El siguiente es un extracto de la edición del 20 de junio de *The Catholic Moment*.

En 2017, Our Sunday Visitor (OSV) lanzó su Planificación de la Visión Parroquial con Katie Herzing como Entrenadora Parroquial. Nuestro modelo de planificación de la visión empleó el uso de un entrenador para guiar y dirigir equipos de planificación de visión parroquial a través del proceso y en los meses posteriores a la presentación de un plan para garantizar que siga siendo un documento vivo y relevante para la vida parroquial.

¿Qué es un Plan de Visión Pastoral?

Un Plan de Visión Pastoral es un documento

escrito y fácil de leer que describe cómo el pastorado piensa crecer en el transcurso de los próximos tres años. Este documento se enfocará en cómo cada pastorado vive los tres pilares de Uniting in Heart: misión, comunidad y testimonio. A través de una serie de reuniones con el Consultor del Pastorado y el Entrenador de OSV, el equipo discernirá sus metas e hitos pastorales para los próximos tres años.

Creando el Plan

El proceso de Planificación de la Visión Pastoral comienza solicitando la opinión de los feligreses de cada pastorado. La intención de la encuesta es darle a cada miembro del pastorado la oportunidad de compartir su experiencia, brindar retroalimentación, indicar sus necesidades futuras y compartir un poco sobre su vida de fe. Estos resultados son compilados por el equipo de OSV y presentados al Equipo de Planificación de la Visión en cada pastorado.

Los miembros del Equipo de Planificación de la Visión revisan los resultados, leen todos los comentarios y discuten las áreas generales en las que quieren enfocar el plan futuro. Luego, el equipo lleva a cabo una "Gran Sesión de Lluvia de Ideas" alimentada por ideas, post-its y conversaciones, todas centradas en las áreas principales de enfoque decididas por

el Equipo de Planificación de la Visión y el Pastor Misionero en consulta con el Consultor Pastoral. El equipo participa en algunas rondas de lluvia de ideas para escribir metas para cada área de enfoque y luego esbozar los hitos potenciales (acciones concretas) para ayudar al pastorado a lograr esas metas en el transcurso de los próximos tres años.

Compartiendo el Plan

El Consultor del Pastorado y el Entrenador de OSV trabajarán en estrecha colaboración con el Pastor Misionero y el Equipo de Planificación de la Visión para garantizar que las metas sean específicas, medibles, alineadas con Uniting in Heart, realistas para el pastorado y fijas al marco de tiempo de tres años. Este plan responde a la pregunta: "¿Cómo es Uniting in Heart en nuestro pastorado?"

Debido a que la misión de Uniting in Heart abarca todos los aspectos de la vida pastoral y de fe, hay algo en el Plan de Visión Pastoral en el que todos pueden participar. Esto podría ser liderar un nuevo ministerio o asistir a una nueva oportunidad para formarse como discípulo misionero. Podría ser atender las necesidades de alguien en la comunidad u orar por la efusión del Espíritu Santo sobre la gente del pastorado. ¡Cada persona tiene un papel que desempeñar en el futuro de la fe!
