Off the Top of My Head...

For not the first time since last August, Fathers Marty, Dave and I are making changes in the weekday Mass schedule at the two Anderson parishes. I appreciate the patience of everyone who has to deal with these changes. We are NOT purposely trying to make your lives more confusing!

Last spring, we developed a summer schedule that afforded the priests the opportunity for some vacation, and time off for Fr. Dave, who was preparing for knee replacement surgery. Now, Fr. Dave has decided to delay his surgery until after retirement next summer. So that means he is available full time until then, God willing.

Several factors led to these changes:

1. At some point soon we will begin celebrating Masses at the correctional facilities at Pendleton. There is a great deal of uncertainty about this and we don't want to add parish Masses back into the schedule only to have to remove them a few weeks later to accommodate these additional Masses.
2. The same dynamic applies to nursing home Masses. If and when Covid numbers decrease permanently, we may be able to resume the regular celebration of nursing home Masses.
3. We currently celebrate Mass every Wednesday at Ascension St. Vincent Hospital but with a restricted number of people. After Covid (let's be optimistic and say that!), we assume that Mass will stay on the schedule and be treated in reality, not only on paper, as a parish Mass for St. Mary's, Anderson, to which the public will be invited.
4. It didn't make sense to us to have Mass at the same (or almost the same) time in two different churches located less than ten minutes away from each other.

So, beginning SEPTEMBER 6, here is our weekday Mass schedule:

- Monday: St. Mary's, Anderson, 8 am
- Tuesday: St. Ambrose, 8 am
- Wednesday: St. Ambrose, 8 am; St. Mary's, Alexandria, 8 am; Ascension St. Vincent Anderson, 11:30 am (this Mass not yet open to the public)
- Thursday: St. Mary's, Anderson, 8:30 am
- Friday: St. Mary's, Alexandria, 8:00 am; St. Ambrose, 8:10 am.

In last week's bulletin I failed to include some important information about Christine Vincent-Rodas, our new Director of Evangelization: She will be responsible for Religious Education and Sacramental Preparation in the Pastorate. She will be working with the processes that we already have, not imposing an entirely new program or approach. Sorry for the omission last week!

Pensamiento del Padre Tom...

Es la primera vez desde agosto pasado, Los padres Marty, Dave y yo estamos haciendo cambios en el horario de misas entre semana en las dos parroquias de Anderson. Agradezco la paciencia de todos los que tienen que lidiar con estos cambios. NO es que queramos hacer sus vidas intencionalmente confusas!

Durante la primavera pasada, desarrollamos un horario de verano que brindó a los sacerdotes la oportunidad de unas vacaciones y tiempo libre para el P. Dave, que se estaba preparando para una cirugía de reemplazo de rodilla. Ahora, el P. Dave ha decidido retrasar su cirugía hasta después de la jubilación el próximo verano. Eso significa que está disponible a tiempo completo hasta entonces, si Dios quiere. Varios factores llevaron a estos cambios:

1. Pronto comenzaremos a celebrar misas en las instalaciones correccionales de Pendleton. Existe una gran incertidumbre sobre esto y no queremos volver a agregar misas parroquiales al programa solo para tener que eliminarlas unas semanas después para dar cabida a estas misas adicionales.
2. La misma dinámica se aplica a las Misas en hogares de ancianos. Si los números de Covid disminuyen permanentemente, es posible que podamos reanudar la celebración regular de misas en hogares de ancianos.
3. Actualmente celebramos misa todos los miércoles en el Hospital Ascensión St. Vicente, pero con un número limitado de personas. Después de Covid (¡seamos optimistas y digamos eso!), Asumimos que la misa se mantendrá en el horario y será tratada en realidad, no solo en papel, si no como una misa parroquial en Sta. María, Anderson, a la que el público será invitado.
4. No tenía sentido tener dos misas casi a la misma hora en dos iglesias diferentes ubicadas a menos de diez minutos una de la otra. Entonces, a partir del 6 de SEPTIEMBRE, aquí está nuestro horario de misas entre semana:

Lunes: Sta. Maria , Anderson, 8 am

Martes: St. Ambrosio, 8 am

Miercoles: St. Ambrosio, 8 am; Sta. María, Alexandria, 8 am; Ascensión St. Vicente Anderson, 11:30 am (Esta misa no está abierta al público toda vía)

Jueves: Sta. Maria, Anderson, 8:30 am

Viernes: Sta. Maria, Alexandria, 8:00 am; St. Ambrosio, 8:10 am.

An Update on St. Mary's Anderson Church Renovation Project Phase 1 and the**"People for the Steeple" Appeal**

St. Mary's (Anderson) parishioners will remember that, beginning in 2017, our parish began raising funds for a variety of repairs to the exterior of the church building, including repair/replacement of flashing, roofing, masonry, gutters, etc. The work began in 2018 and was completed in 2019, under budget and fully paid in the amount of \$284,763. That work was considered Phase 1 of an overall project approved by the Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Finance Council. We will conduct a special Pulpit Appeal on the last two weekends of August to raise funds for the costs of Phase 2 of this project, which will encompass repairs to the ornamental metal work, masonry, windows, and other elements of the steeple/bell tower.

Many thanks to all who contributed financially to our Church Renovation Project Phase 1, and to those who prayed for its success. You helped to make this important and essential work possible!
