Off the Top of My Head...

“ ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you...?’ ‘Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers or sisters of mine, you did for me.’ “(Matthew 25:34-40)

In the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate there are not one or two, but four ministries that feed the hungry, in response to the invitation expressed Matthew’s description of the Last Judgment.

What are these four ministries?

St. Mary’s in Alexandria supports the local food pantry, “Pete’s Pantry.” Despite extensive research on my part (well, not extensive, and not really research, although I did ask around!), I have not learned the origin of this interesting and catchy name. I do know that Pete’s Pantry is a ministry of the Lutheran Church of Our Blessed Savior in Alexandria and provides not only canned and boxed food, but also meat and fresh produce, to the hungry of Alexandria, Orestes, Summitville and Frankton. Donations from St. Mary’s parishioners have decreased over the past year – due to the Pandemic, no doubt – and I am hopeful that these donations will soon increase in both frequency and quantity.

St. Mary’s in Anderson houses the other three feeding ministries, two of which are supported by parishioners from both St. Mary’s and St. Ambrose. Both parishes support the long-running Soup Kitchen ministry, which prepares soup three times each month for residents of the Alternatives Shelter for Women and Children and for residents of the Christian Center Shelter for Men. Parishioners pick up the ingredients at St. Mary’s (Anderson), prepare the soup at home, and return it to St. Mary’s. St. Mary’s in Anderson also sponsors a Food Pantry which is open three days a week and provides essentials for those who come to the parish office. Parishioners of St. Mary’s and St. Ambrose provide donations of food and funding for this ministry. The numbers of those making use of the pantry is gradually increasing. Twice a month, St. Mary’s in Anderson also provides fresh produce from Second Harvest Food Bank. Presently, most of that produce goes to members of our own parish and school community, but we would like to make these offerings available to neighborhood families as well. The support for this ministry has come from grants from outside the parish.

I share this information both to inform and to invite you to consider supporting or participating in these ministries.

En la Pastoral Anderson-Alexandría no hay uno o dos, sino cuatro ministerios que alimentan a los hambrientos, en respuesta a la invitación expresada en la lectura de Mateo del Juicio Final.

¿Cuáles son estos cuatro ministerios?

Sta. Maria en Axandría apoya la despensa de alimentos local, "Pete's Pantry". A pesar de una extensa investigación de mi parte (bueno, no extensa, y no realmente investigación, ¡aunque pregunté!), No he aprendido el origen de este nombre interesante y pegadizo. Sé que Pete's Pantry es un ministerio de la Iglesia Luterana de Nuestro Bendito Salvador en Alexandria y proporciona no solo alimentos enlatados y en caja, sino también carne y productos frescos, a los hambrientos de Alexandria, Orestes, Summitville y Frankton. Las donaciones de los feligreses de Sta. Maria han disminuido durante el año pasado, debido a la pandemia, sin duda, y tengo la esperanza de que estas donaciones aumenten pronto tanto en frecuencia como en cantidad.

Sta. Maria en Anderson alberga los otros tres ministerios de alimentos, dos de los cuales son apoyados por feligreses de Sta. Maria y St. Ambrose.

Ambas parroquias apoyan el ministerio de Comedor Social, que prepara sopa tres veces al mes para los residentes del Refugio Alternativo para Mujeres y Niños y para los residentes del Refugio para Hombres del Centro Cristiano. Los feligreses recogen los ingredientes en Sta. Maria (Anderson), preparan la sopa en casa y la devuelven a Sta. Maria.

Sta. Maria en Anderson también patrocina una despensa de alimentos que está abierta tres días a la semana y proporciona lo esencial para aquellos que vienen a la oficina parroquial. Los feligreses de St. Maria y St. Ambrose brindan donaciones de alimentos y fondos para este ministerio. El número de personas que hacen uso de la despensa está aumentando gradualmente.

Dos veces al mes, Sta. Maria en Anderson también ofrece productos frescos del Second Harvest Food Bank. Actualmente, la mayoría de esos productos van a los miembros de nuestra propia parroquia y comunidad escolar, pero también nos gustaría poner estas ofertas a disposición de las familias del vecindario. El apoyo a este ministerio proviene de subvenciones de fuera de la parroquia.

Comparto esta información tanto para informarlos como para invitarlos a considerar apoyar o participar en estos ministerios.
