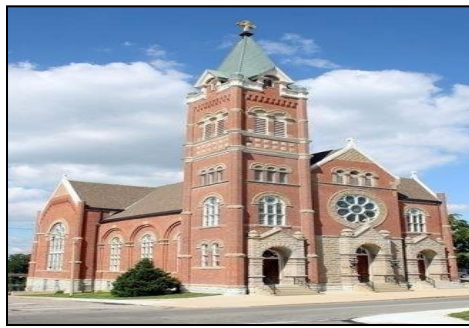

Hello, my name is Christine Vincent-Rodas and I am honored to serve as the Director of Evangelization, Family Life and Pastoral Ministries for the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate. When I was in 2nd grade, I wanted to be a missionary – specifically a missionary in Russia. I wanted people to know Jesus, to know His love for them and to love Him. At times, I thought about being a teacher or a lawyer or an architect but the calling to be a missionary returned again when I was a junior in high school – but this time I didn't know where God wanted me to go.

Little did I realize, my journey as a missionary started back in 2nd grade when my guitar teacher invited my classmates and me to serve as music ministers for the children's Mass. I served as a music minister each week for 20 years until God called me to serve in another area of ministry – youth ministry. I vividly remember a conversation with my best friend, a fellow youth minister, about what God was going to call us to after youth ministry. I thought my friend was crazy and said I couldn't imagine God calling me to anything other than youth ministry. My friend warned me not to put limits on God or where He would call me.

I am forever grateful for the Holy Spirit speaking that prophetic message through my friend. I would never have imagined that God's calling me to be His missionary disciple would lead me to serve as Director of Religious Education at a large parish in Los Altos, California; Associate Director for Human Dignity and Life for the Diocese of San Jose; Associate Director for Lay Ministry Formation for the Diocese of Sacramento; Coordinator of Hispanic Ministry Formation for the Diocese of Evansville and most recently Pastoral Associate for St. John Vianney parish in Fishers.

God has opened the doors to prepare and equip me on this journey, allowing me to obtain a Bachelor's Degree in Pastoral Leadership from Marian College, a Master's Degree in Catholic Thought and Life, as well as Post-Graduate Certificates in Church History and in Systematic Theology. I even was blessed to begin work on a Doctorate in Theology, which I hope to finish one day. We are never sent out alone. The Holy Spirit and others journey with us. I have been blessed to have many special people accompany me over the years, especially my husband Antonio and my 7 children.

At our Baptism, we each were called to be disciples of Jesus, at Confirmation each one of us were sent out into the world on mission, and each week Christ renews us through the Mass and strengthens us for our mission by giving us His body, the Eucharist. While God has not sent me to Russia, the Holy Spirit showed me that I wasn't being called to mission in a distant land but right here. I invite you to reflect on your life – where has God called you over the years and how has the Holy Spirit worked through you to bring the love of Jesus.

Hola, mi nombre es Christine Vincent-Rodas y es un honor para mí servir como Directora de Evangelización, Vida Familiar y Ministerios Pastorales de la Pastoral Anderson-Alexandria. Cuando estaba en segundo grado, quería ser misionero, específicamente un misionero en Rusia. Quería que la gente conociera a Jesús, que conociera su amor por ellos y que lo amaran. A veces, pensaba en ser maestra, abogada o arquitecta, pero el llamado a ser misionero regresó cuando estaba en la escuela secundaria, pero esta vez no sabía a dónde quería Dios que fuera.

Yo no sabía, mi viaje como misionero comenzó en segundo grado cuando mi maestra de guitarra nos invitó a mis compañeros de clase y a mí a servir como ministros de música para la Misa de niños. Serví como ministro de música cada semana durante 20 años hasta que Dios me llamó a servir en otra área del ministerio: el ministerio de jóvenes. Recuerdo vívidamente una conversación con mi mejor amigo, un compañero ministro de jóvenes, sobre a qué nos iba a llamar Dios después del ministerio de jóvenes. Pensé que mi amigo estaba loco y dije que no podía imaginarme a Dios llamándome a otra cosa que no fuera el ministerio de jóvenes. Mi amigo me advirtió que no pusiera límites a Dios ni a dónde me llamaría.

Siempre estaré agradecido por el Espíritu Santo hablando ese mensaje profético a través de mi amigo. Nunca hubiera imaginado que el llamado de Dios para ser su discípulo misionero me llevaría a servir como Director de Educación Religiosa en una gran parroquia en Los Altos, California; Director Asociado de Dignidad Humana y Vida de la Diócesis de San José; Director Asociado de Formación de Ministerios Laicos para la Diócesis de Sacramento; Coordinador de Formación del Ministerio Hispano para la Diócesis de Evansville y más recientemente Asociado Pastoral de la parroquia St. John Vianney en Fishers.

Dios ha abierto las puertas para prepararme y equiparme en este viaje, permitiéndome obtener una Licenciatura en Liderazgo Pastoral de Marian College, una Maestría en Pensamiento y Vida Católica, así como Certificados de Postgrado en Historia de la Iglesia y en Sistemática. Teología. Incluso tuve la suerte de comenzar a trabajar en un Doctorado en Teología, que espero terminar algún día. Nunca nos envían solos. El Espíritu Santo y otros viajan con nosotros. He tenido la suerte de contar con muchas personas especiales que me acompañaron a lo largo de los años, especialmente mi esposo Antonio y mis 7 hijos.

En nuestro Bautismo, todos fuimos llamados a ser discípulos de Jesús, en la Confirmación cada uno de nosotros fuimos enviados al mundo en misión, y cada semana Cristo nos renueva a través de la Misa y nos fortalece para nuestra misión al darnos Su cuerpo, la Eucaristía. Si bien Dios no me ha enviado a Rusia, el Espíritu Santo me mostró que no estaba siendo llamado a una misión en una tierra lejana sino aquí mismo. Te invito a reflexionar sobre tu vida: dónde te ha llamado Dios a lo largo de los años y cómo ha trabajado el Espíritu Santo a través de ti para traer el amor de Jesús.
